

GETTING STARTED

How much sleep have you "lost" in the past week? Why?

REFLECTION/DISCUSSION QUESTIONS

- 1. What do vs. 1-3 (below) sound like? Look like? Feel like? What might David be losing sleep over?
- 2. Read Psalm 4:1(below). What four things does David ask of God in this verse?
- 3. What outcome does David expect? Why is he so confident in vs. 8?
- 4. Of the four reasons shared in the message of why people don't pray, which one can you relate to the most? (Not sure how, get distracted, think requests are too small, not sure prayer will really make a difference)
- 5. Share honestly about your own prayer life. What is working? What isn't working? How could you build a "morning or evening prayer" into your daily routine? Is a routine for everyone? (P.R.A.Y)
- 6. "Talk to God with gut-level honesty. Talk to God about everything—big or small." Is this easy or difficult for you? Why or why not?
- 7. What are the prayer requests on your mind and heart today?

PRAYER: Lord God, thank you for the prayers recorded in Scripture. Thank you for David's honesty and trust in you. Thank you for his faithfulness in bringing his requests before you daily. Help us to be consistent in developing a relationship with you through continual prayer. Keep us centered and focused on you. In the name of Christ, we pray, Amen.

GOING DEEPER: Read Psalms 1-5. What kinds of things do you hear David praying about? How honest is he before God about how he feels? How can David's approach encourage you in your own prayer life?

"O Lord, hear me as I pray; pay attention to my groaning. Listen to my cry for help, my King and my God, for I pray to no one but you. Listen to my voice in the morning, Lord. Each morning, I bring my requests to you and wait expectantly."
