



GETTING STARTED

What was the best part of your Christmas celebration this year?

REFLECTION/DISCUSSION QUESTIONS

- 1. How would you like to have John the Baptist as your pastor? How would his dress code be accepted in your church?
- 2. Why would anyone go out of their way to hear this radical preacher (v.7)? Who did they think he was (2 Kings 1:8)?
- 3. How would you paraphrase John's message (v.2) for people today? What is the "kingdom of heaven?"
- 4. What similarities and differences do you find in John's ministry and Jesus' ministry?
- 5. When has repentance been especially important in your life? Where have you perhaps strayed off the path and want to get back on track as we start 2026?
- 6. What do "fruits worthy of repentance" look like in your life today?
- 7. What are the prayer requests on your mind and heart today?

PRAYER: Lord God, thank you for the ministry of John the Baptist. He came to prepare the way in the hearts of your people. Help us to hear your message through his words today and apply them to our lives. May we repent of what is needed as we start this new year. May our lives reflect the fruit of your Holy Spirit at work in our hearts. Thank you for this fresh start. In the name of Christ, we pray, Amen.

GOING DEEPER: Read Matthew 3:1-12, Mark 1:1-8, and Luke 3:1-20. What similarities and differences do you find in these accounts of John's mission and ministry? Why is John so important to the story of Jesus? Who has been a John the Baptist in your life? How did he or she prepare you to meet Jesus?

"In those days John the Baptist came to the Judean wilderness and began preaching. His message was, 'Repent of your sins and turn to God, for the Kingdom of Heaven is near.' The prophet Isaiah was speaking about John when he said, 'He is a voice shouting in the wilderness, 'Prepare the way for the Lord's coming!' John's clothes were woven from coarse camel hair... For food he ate locusts and wild honey. People from Jerusalem and from all over the Jordan Valley went out to see and hear John. And when they confessed their sins, he baptized them in the Jordan River."
