**BIG IDEA: GOD MIGHT USE ONE INVITATION TO CHANGE A LIFE**

“Then the King will say to those on his right, ‘Come, you who are blessed by my Father, inherit the Kingdom prepared for you from the creation of the world. For I was hungry, and you fed me. I was thirsty, and you gave me a drink. I was a stranger, and you invited me into your home. I was naked, and you gave me clothing. I was sick, and you cared for me. I was in prison, and you visited me.’ ‘When did we ever see you sick or in prison and visit you?’ And the King will say, ‘I tell you truth, when you did it to one of the least of these my brothers and sisters, you were doing it to me.’ Matthew 25: 34-36, 39-40

## MY NOTES:

### GETTING STARTED

Where do you keep your prized possessions? What do you value the most?

### REFLECTION/DISCUSSION QUESTIONS

1. Who is Jesus speaking to in this passage? What is his audience? (see Mt. 24:3)
2. What does this section teach about Christian responsibility? Who are the “least of these brothers of mine”?
3. In these six areas (v.35-36), where do you find yourself serving most naturally? In which areas do you have the most trouble reaching out?
4. Share about a time that God used an invitation to impact someone’s life in a positive way.
5. How does a mindset of generosity impact the way that you serve others?
6. What is God calling you to invest in the work of Christ through Redeemer Church? How can you give and serve out of the overflow of what He has given to you?
7. What are the prayer requests on your mind and heart today?

**PRAYER:** Father, thank you for the many ways you are moving in our church and community. We’re so grateful you use people like us to make a difference. We’re ready to use what we have to show your love to the people around us. Please help us to love and serve others well. In Jesus’ name, we pray, Amen.

**GOING DEEPER:** Read Matthew 25:1-46. What overall message is Jesus communicating here with these three parables? Where are the similarities and differences between each parable? If the Master returned today, how much of your talents and potential would he say you are using for him right now? How are you investing your time and talents in His kingdom work?
