Big Idea:

STAY CLOSE TO GOD IN THE MIDST OF BUSYNESS

GETTING STARTED

Share a time when you last went through a stressful, busy season. What did you learn?

REFLECTION/DISCUSSION QUESTIONS

- In Psalm 127 below, what work does Solomon criticize? How do those who rely on their own efforts see their work?
- 2. Have you ever been called a "workaholic?" Why? How are you dealing with it?
- 3. In Psalm 103 below, which word picture of forgiveness do you like best?
- 4. Which do you tend to be: a complainer or a praiser? Satisfied or dissatisfied? Why? Has affliction made you positive or negative?
- 5. When have you experienced God's grace first-hand? How have you benefited from it?
- 6. In what practical ways have you stayed close to God in the midst of a busy season in life? Or what would you like to put in place for the next busy season?
- 7. What are the prayer requests on your mind and heart today?

PRAYER: Lord God, thank you for your forgiveness and love, even in the busy seasons of our lives. We confess that there is often the temptation to get too busy to spend time with you or go to church. Help us to remain connected to the source of our spiritual strength. May we find rest in You. In the name of Christ, we pray, Amen.

<u>GOING DEEPER</u>: Read Psalm 103:1-22. What do you hear in the language that David uses here? Do you think he is going through a good time or a difficult time in life? Which section of verses speaks to you at this point in your life?

FOCUS SCRIPTURES: JUNE 12, 2022

"Unless the Lord builds a house, the work of the builders is useless. Unless the Lord protects a city, guarding it with sentries will do no good. It is useless for you to work so hard from early morning until late at night, anxiously working for food to eat; for God gives rest to his loved ones." Psalm 127:1-2 (NLT)

"For as high as the heavens are above the earth, so great is his love for those who fear him; as far as the east is from the west, so far has he removed our transgressions from us. As a father has compassion on his children, so the Lord has compassion on those who fear him..." Psalm 103:11-13
