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



GETTING STARTED

Who is someone you admire for standing up for what they believe?

REFLECTION/DISCUSSION QUESTIONS

- 1. At the dedication ceremony for the king's statue (v.4-8), what was the audience commanded to do? By whom? With what result?
- 2. What do you admire most about the three men in this story?
- 3. Who or what do you think the fourth figure in the furnace was? (an optical illusion, an angel, the Son of God, a mystery)
- 4. Have you had a bad day recently? How can something as ordinary as a bad day challenge your faith?
- 5. What would have happened if Shadrach, Meshach, and Abednego would have bowed or compromised their faith? How have you seen compromise affect your faith?
- 6. Is there a trial or decision you need to take a firm stand in? Or is there something you know God wants you to do that you need to obey? What steps will you take this week?
- 7. What are the prayer requests on your mind and heart today?

<u>PRAYER</u>: Lord God, we look to you for courage to stand firm in trials, so that we might honor You and reveal Jesus to the world. Help us to be obedient and to trust you for the outcome. May we not give in to compromise. In the name of Christ, we pray, Amen.

GOING DEEPER: Read Daniel 2:1-3:30. What kind of relationship had developed between Daniel and his three friends and King Nebuchadnezzar? Why was the king so harsh with these leaders? When have you had to stand firm for something you believed? What was the result? How do you remain faithful "even if he does not" rescue you?

"Shadrach, Meshach, and Abednego replied to the king, 'O Nebuchadnezzar, we do not need to defend ourselves before you in this matter. If we are thrown into the blazing furnace, the God we serve is able to save us from it, and he will rescue us from your hand, O king. But even if he does not, we want you to know, O king, that we will not serve your gods or worship the image of gold you have set up." Daniel 3:16-18. "They saw that the fire had not harmed their bodies, nor was a hair of their heads singed; their robes were not scorched, and there was no smell of fire on them."
