

GETTING STARTED

What is the worst investment (of time, money, etc.) you ever made? Why?

REFLECTION/DISCUSSION QUESTIONS

- 1. What happens when you "cast your bread" (v.1)? How will the giving of "portions" help in a time of disaster (v.2)?
- 2. Read Ecclesiastes 11:6. How does the advice here relate to the advice in vs. 1? How does this relate to your own life today?
- 3. How much do "eternal concerns" affect your daily decisions? Which areas of your life are most influenced by your faith in God? Which are least?
- 4. What is the biggest challenge for you in growing older? How does it affect your attitude in being "grumpy" or "grateful?"
- 5. How can you "remember your Creator in the days of your youth"? How can you help children to do so?
- 6. How has your faith in God affected your outlook on aging? On dying? On death? Which do you fear most? Or do you truly yearn for one of these? Why?
- 7. What are the prayer requests on your mind and heart today?

PRAYER: Lord God, thank you for the time and years that you have given to us on this earth. May we be generous and share what we have. Help us to "age well" and remember you all of our days. May gratitude characterize our hearts and lives and overflow to others. In the name of Christ, we pray, Amen.

GOING DEEPER: Read Ecclesiastes 11:1-12:7. What is the overall theme that King Solomon is trying to communicate here? As you grow older, which do you want to hold on to most: (a) youthful body, (b) youthful mind, (c) youthful heart? How does generosity and gratitude affect the aging process? What does it mean in your own life?

"Cast your bread upon the waters, for after many days you will find it again. Give portions to seven, yes to eight, for you do not know what disaster may come upon the land." V.9: "Young people, it's wonderful to be young! Enjoy every minute of it. Do you everything you want to do; take it all in. But remember that you must give an account to God for everything you do. So refuse to worry, and keep your body healthy... Don't let the excitement of youth cause you to forget your Creator. Honor him in your youth before you grow old and say, 'Life is not pleasant anymore."
