BIG IDEA | COME TO THE MANGER TO WORSHIP HIM

“For a child is born to us, a son is given to us. The government will rest on his shoulders. And he will be called: Wonderful Counselor, Mighty God, Everlasting Father, Prince of Peace. His government and its peace will never end. He will rule with fairness and justice from the throne of his ancestor David for all eternity. The zeal of the Lord Almighty will accomplish this!”
Isaiah 9:6-7

“But the angel said, ‘Don’t be afraid! I bring you good news of great joy that will be for all the people. Today in the town of David a Savior has been born to you; he is Christ the Lord.’”

GETTING STARTED

Were you ever in a Christmas program? What part did you play?

REFLECTION/DISCUSSION QUESTIONS

1. What expectations would awaken in you if you had first heard these words from Isaiah (see below)? What type of son or ruler would you expect to arise?
2. Of the titles given in vs. 6, which fit Jesus as you know him? How does this make you feel?
3. What is the purpose of His reign in your life? In the world? What does it mean that there will be no end to the increase and peace of His reign?
4. In what ways does the busyness of the Christmas season make you feel weary and burdened?
5. What activities bring you joy in this season? What robs you of joy? What can help you to focus on Christ in these days?
6. Where do you need Jesus’ help to become triumphant in overcoming an obstacle you are facing?
7. What are the prayer requests on your mind and heart today?

PRAYER: Lord Jesus, thank you for coming to earth as a baby. You gave “great joy” to the people long ago and you continue to do the same today. May we take time to worship and experience your joy in the busyness of this season. Help us to be faithful and triumphant in following after your example of love and grace. In the name of Christ, we pray, Amen.

GOING DEEPER: How does the New Testament interpret what this prophecy from Isaiah means? (Read Isaiah 9:1-9, Matthew 4:12-17, Luke 1:32, John 8:12) What similarities and differences do you see? How has the news of Jesus’ birth been “great joy” to you over the years? How does worship produce joy in your life? Who do you want to share “the news” with this Christmas?
