MESSAGE: WHO IS THE HOLY SPIRIT?

August 4, 2024

Text: John 14:16-17; 16:7-15

Pew Bible pages: 896 & 898

BIG IDEA: THE HOLY SPIRIT COMES TO COUNSEL, COMFORT, AND CONVICT

“And I will ask the Father, and he will give you another Advocate, who will never leave you. He is the Holy Spirit, who leads you into all truth. The world cannot receive him, because it isn’t looking for him and doesn’t recognize him. But you know him, because he lives with you now and later will be in you.”

John 14:16-17

“But in fact, it is best for you that I go away, because if I don’t, the Advocate won’t come. If I do go away, then I will send him to you. And when he comes, he will convict the world of its sin, and of God’s righteousness, and of the coming judgment. V.13: When the Spirit of truth comes, he will guide you into all truth.”

John 16:7-8,13

GETTING STARTED

Who is a trusted advisor or friend that you turn to for advice? Why was this person so special?

REFLECTION/DISCUSSION QUESTIONS

1. What do you learn about the Holy Spirit in John 14:16-17, 25-27, 16:7-15?
2. What was your understanding of the Holy Spirit before this week’s message? If applicable, how did you picture the Holy Spirit growing up?
3. Why did Jesus take time the night before he died in the Upper Room to describe the role of the Holy Spirit to the disciples?
4. What is the relationship of the Father, Son, and Holy Spirit to the believer? To each other?
5. When you think back, can you see a time when the Holy Spirit was leading you? How did He comfort, counsel, or convict you?
6. How do you, practically, feel the presence of the Holy Spirit in your life?
7. What are the prayer requests on your mind and heart today?

PRAYER: Lord Jesus, thank you for sending the Holy Spirit to work in the hearts and lives of the disciples so long ago. You promise that the Holy Spirit will be with us to comfort, counsel and convict. May we respond faithfully to the voice of the Holy Spirit in our daily lives. In the name of Christ, we pray, Amen.

GOING DEEPER: Read John 14:15--16:15. What tone of voice do you hear from Jesus in these chapters? Of all the promises here about the Holy Spirit (v.16-18, 25-27; 16:5-15), which ones mean the most to you? Why?
