

GETTING STARTED

What is something crazy you have done for love?

REFLECTION/DISCUSSION QUESTIONS

- 1. "O God, you are my God, earnestly I seek you...My soul clings to you; your right hand upholds me." How do you pursue God or feel God's love for you?
- 2. "Pursue her with words of affection. Pursue him with words of affirmation." Why is this important in marriages and close relationships?
- 3. "When you think something special, do it." Is there ever a gap between your intentions and actions? What are the obstacles?
- 4. What is some good that you need to do for your marriage/close relationships? OR What is something God might be asking you to do that you have been putting off?
- 5. "If you want something different, be it." How might you put this into action right away? What is God putting on your heart to change?
- 6. Who could you share these principles with this week?
- 7. What are the prayer requests on your mind and heart today?

PRAYER: Jesus, thank you for the gift of love. You demonstrated unconditional love for us in giving yourself on the cross. Help us also to model that same kind of love for our spouses and families, to keep pursuing each other, even through the challenges of life. In the name of Jesus, we pray. Amen.

GOING DEEPER: Read Genesis 29:1-30. This chapter describes the love story of Jacob and Rachel. What do you notice about Jacob's pursuit of Rachel? What challenges did he encounter? How did God provide?
