ADVENT HOUSE THANK YOU



BIG IDEA: HOPE IN THE MIDST OF THE PAIN OF OUR WORLD

GETTING STARTED

In your family, who tried to keep the peace? Mom or Dad or someone else?

REFLECTION/DISCUSSION QUESTIONS

- 1. Out of the areas of suffering, perseverance, character and hope, where is God working in your life right now?
- 2. How can a Christian look upon suffering and stress? Upon disappointment?
- 3. What incident in your life can you look back on and see the truth of vs 3-5?
- 4. Where do you struggle the most in reconciling a good God with the tragedies of our world?
- 5. What does the Holy Spirit do for us when we do not know how to pray? When is the last time you didn't know how to pray and the Holy Spirit helped or comforted you? (8:26-27)
- 6. What have you found helpful in dealing with pain and suffering? What "present sufferings" are you struggling with? Where do you find hope?
- 7. What are the prayer requests on your mind and heart today?

PRAYER: Lord Jesus, if we are truly honest, we struggle when we see suffering in our world or in our lives or others. It is hard and painful. Thank you that you intercede and pray for us when we can't even find the words to say. Help us to trust you through times of suffering and to persevere. May we find our hope in you. In the name of Christ, Amen.

GOING DEEPER: Read Romans 5:1-21. How much of God's peace and hope need to begin with a feeling and how much must begin with head knowledge and conscious claiming of peace and hope? What does "reconciliation" mean to you? (5:11) How does this chapter illustrate why "grace and peace to you" is such an appropriate greeting for Christians?
