

Getting Real with God

Matthew 5:38-45; Pew Bible page 803

Big Idea: BE AUTHENTIC AND REAL BEFORE GOD AND OTHERS

GETTING STARTED

Did you grow up in an openly "religious" home? Or was religion a private matter, unseen by you until later years?

REFLECTION/DISCUSSION QUESTIONS

- 1. What does this passage tell you about the approach Jesus wants us to have toward giving? (v.1-4)
- 2. Where do you go when you need to pray? What do you find yourself praying about most often?
- 3. Jesus gives the people a model for prayer in vs.9-13. What has the Lord's Prayer meant to you over the years?
- 4. What do vs.12,14-15 say to you about forgiving and being forgiven?
- 5. What is the purpose of fasting? In what situations might fasting be helpful? Share an experience of fasting from your own life.
- 6. Why does Jesus address this issue of authenticity in our spiritual life? When have you, perhaps, tried to "manage your image?" How is it freeing to be real before God and others?
- 7. What are the prayer requests on your mind and heart today?

PRAYER: Jesus, thank you for teaching us how to pray with the model of the Lord's Prayer. Help us to bring all of our concerns before you, knowing that you will provide for every need. Help us to be honest and authentic in how we give and how we pray. May we honor you in all that we do. In the name of Christ, we pray, Amen.

GOING DEEPER: Read Matthew 6:1-34. When you pray, what do you find to be your biggest challenge? How does prayer relate to Jesus' section about not worrying? What is God saying to you through this passage about handling your particular worry or disappointment?
