

GETTING STARTED

Imagine your life five years from now. What would be the same? What might be different?

REFLECTION/DISCUSSION QUESTIONS

- 1. How does Paul's urgency in vs.11 influence your perspective on life?
- 2. How do you obtain the "clothing" in vs.14? How would you use this section to explain holiness?
- 3. How would your life be different if you consciously tried to "wear" Jesus Christ?
- 4. "The things you let in become the ways you are set in." What are some good habits that are helpful to you? What are patterns or habits that you would like to change?
- 5. "Teach us to number our days, that we may gain a heart of wisdom." (Psalm 90:12) How does this verse speak to you? What does it mean for daily living?
- 6. "Don't put off to tomorrow what you need to do today." What is one action step of change that you can take today in this new school year that will help you reach your Godgiven calling?
- 7. What are the prayer requests on your mind and heart today?

PRAYER: Lord Jesus, help us to number our days and be thankful for each breath that you have given to us. Every morning, help us to remember to put on the clothes of Christ. May we monitor the things that we let in so we can become set in good habits to grow closer to you. Help us to reflect you in all that we do. In Jesus' name, we pray, Amen .

GOING DEEPER: Read Romans 13: 8-14. How does Paul's concept of love differ from today's popular notions of love? How does love fulfill all of the other commandments? In what practical way can you show love to a neighbor this week?
