BIG IDEA: GOD'S WORD IS THE SOURCE OF WISDOM FOR LIFE

GETTING STARTED

Describe a favorite coach or mentor for you growing up. What impact did this person have on your life?

REFLECTION/DISCUSSION QUESTIONS

- 1. What role did Biblical wisdom play in Solomon's early life? (v.4-7)
- 2. How can God's Word keep you prepared and help you to make wise decisions?
- 3. What Biblical character has been a "divine mentor" for you lately? How have you learned from his/her example?
- 4. Share time when you made a wise or unwise choice. What did you learn or gain from it?
- "Guard your heart above all else, for it determines the course of your life"(v.23).
 Where have you seen evidence of this truth in your life?
- 6. How is reading Scripture impacting your life currently? If someone asked you why it is important in your life, how would you answer?
- 7. What are the prayer requests on your mind and heart today?

PRAYER: Lord Jesus, thank you for Your Word that continually guides us and teaches us. May we be faithful to listen to your voice and apply it to our lives. We are so grateful for Scripture that grounds us and keeps us on a solid path. We ask for your wisdom to grow in us each day. In the name of Christ, we pray, Amen.

GOING DEEPER: Read Proverbs 4:1-27. In this proverb, are there more "Do's or "Don'ts"? Why might that be? How does Solomon describe the value of wisdom? Is the way to wisdom well-traveled, or less traveled? In what area of your life do you need the counsel of vs.25-27? What other verses stand out to you here? How can they apply to your life?

"My father taught me, 'Take my words to heart. Follow my commands, and you will live. Get wisdom; develop good judgment. Don't forget my words or turn away from them. Don't turn your back on wisdom, for she will protect you. Love her, and she will guard you. Getting wisdom is the wisest thing you can do! And whatever else you do, develop good judgment...Guard your heart above all else, for it determines the course of your life."
