

GETTING STARTED

Ever ask help from a stranger? What happened? Did it renew or disappoint your faith in humanity?

REFLECTION/DISCUSSION QUESTIONS

- 1. What big problem do the kings and their armies encounter (v.9)? Why is it only at this point of desperation that they turn to a prophet of the Lord (v.11)?
- 2. How does Elisha respond to King Joram and King Jehoshaphat (v.13-14)? Why?
- 3. Why does Elisha want music (v.14; see I Samuel 10:5-6)? Does music help you to worship or to pray? Why?
- 4. How do you think Elisha's advice will set with the soldiers awaiting relief from thirst (v.16 -18)? What faith must the people show in order to see God act on their behalf?
- 5. "Your greatest need becomes a blessing when it drives you to depend on God." Share a time when this was true in your life.
- 6. "Real faith believes big but is willing to start small." When have you had a big dream and took the first steps to fulfill it? What was easy or hard about the process?
- 7. What are the prayer requests on your mind and heart today?

<u>PRAYER</u>: Lord God, thank you for your power and your provision when we put our faith into action. Help us to dream big and be willing to start small. May we trust you in faith to meet our greatest needs. In Jesus' name, we pray, Amen.

<u>GOING DEEPER</u>: Read 2 Kings 2:15—3:27. How does Elisha work with God to heal the water? What personality qualities do you see in Elisha here? How does he hear from the Lord?

"So the king of Israel set out with the king of Judah and the king of Edom. After a roundabout march of seven days, the army had no more water for themselves or for the animals with them. What!' exclaimed the king of Israel. 'Has the Lord called us three kings together only to hand us over to Moab?' But Jehoshaphat asked, 'Is there no prophet of the Lord here, that we may inquire of the Lord through him?' v.15—While the harpist was playing, the hand of the Lord came upon Elisha and he said, 'This is what the Lord says: Make this valley full of ditches. You will see neither wind nor rain, yet this valley will be filled with water, and you, your cattle, and other animals will drink."
