

#### **GETTING STARTED**

Share your baptism experience. Were you young or older? Where? Or not yet?

#### **REFLECTION/DISCUSSION QUESTIONS**

- 1. What motivates you to live a God-honoring life?
- 2. In this passage, "death" and "died" are used many times. What is the main point Paul is trying to make?
- 3. How is the image of baptism a symbol of what Christ did?
- 4. What does baptism mean to you? Why is it important?
- 5. What does it mean to be "dead to sin" and "alive to Christ" in practical terms?
- 6. Describe the process of sanctification. How does the Holy Spirit fill your life and help you to live more like Christ?
- 7. What are the prayer requests on your mind and heart today?

**PRAYER:** Lord Jesus, thank you for the great joy of being welcomed into your family. Baptism is the outward symbol of that work in our hearts. Help us to live into the new life that you offer to each one of us. May we be energized and strengthened to carry on your work in our world. In the name of Christ, we pray. Amen.

**GOING DEEPER:** Read Romans 6:1-23. If Paul were around today, what would he say enslaves our society? What about the Christian community? On a scale of 1 (not very) to 10 (very), how wholeheartedly did you serve God this past week? In what area of your life can you commit to being a willing servant of God this week?
