FAMILY MINISTRIES - PRESCHOOL THRU GRADE 5



Big Idea: MAKE YOUR WORDS COUNT

GETTING STARTED

In describing your conversational style, are you: a closed book, speak your mind, or nice & easy?

REFLECTION/DISCUSSION QUESTIONS

- 1. Who is Jesus talking to in this passage (see vs. 24)? What do you know about this group of people? How did Jesus interact with them?
- 2. In your mind, what is one of the most powerful statements that Jesus made in the gospels? What about it makes an impact on you?
- 3. Share an example of at time you wished you could have taken back written words, either in-print or online. What happened? What did you learn?
- 4. "For out of the overflow of the heart the mouth speaks." (v.34) What is Jesus saying here? How does it apply to written and spoken words in our everyday lives?
- 5. What difference does Jesus' power make in your daily speech with others? In your social media presence? In your emails?
- 6. What are the prayer requests on your mind and heart today?

PRAYER: Lord Jesus, we are so thankful for the words that you spoke and the faithful people who wrote down what you said. You spoke life into people and you challenged people. Thank you that we can go back and study your words. Help us to be faithful and diligent to follow your example in all that we do. In the name of Christ we pray, Amen.

GOING DEEPER: Read Matthew chapter 12. What stands out to you about the words Jesus said? What tone does he use? How do people interact with him? What questions does he ask? What speaks to you heart?
