BIG IDEA: REMEMBER WHAT JESUS HAS DONE IN YOUR LIFE

GETTING STARTED

What is the best reunion you've ever had with family or friends?

REFLECTION/DISCUSSION QUESTIONS

- 1. After the Resurrection, why do you think Peter and the disciples went back to Peter's home territory of Galilee? (about 90 miles)
- 2. In fishing all night, do you think Peter just wanted something to do, or did he return to his old business?
- 3. Why might Jesus have provided a miraculous catch of fish and then made breakfast for the disciples? (ref. Luke 5:1-11)
- 4. Share a "transition time" in your life. Where can you look back and see God's hand in it?
- 5. How did Peter and the disciples embrace a new way of ministry, without Jesus' physical presence but empowered by the Holy Spirit?
- 6. If you were writing a book about Jesus' work in your life, what would be some of the chapter titles?
- 7. What are the prayer requests on your mind and heart today?

PRAYER: Lord Jesus, thank you that you appeared to the disciples several times after the resurrection to encourage them and to help them focus on the mission. Help us, in times of transition in our lives, to see where you are leading us. May we recognize your work and your love. Forgive us when we have gotten distracted or stepped off the path. Restore us to new life. In the name of Christ, Amen.

GOING DEEPER: Read John 21:1-25. Why do you think Jesus asked Peter three times, 'Do you truly love me?' If Jesus asked you the same question, how would you respond? What helps to restore you after you have "blown" it? What did Peter learn here about Jesus' forgiveness? What does it teach you about forgiveness?
