

What's the best piece of relationship advice you've received?

REFLECTION/DISCUSSION QUESTIONS

- 1. How does Ruth's loyalty to Naomi, and Boaz's loyalty to Ruth, defy historical prejudices of the original readers, given Israel-Moab relations in that time?
- 2. What is the most significant way Boaz honors Ruth in this story?
- 3. Which part of this message was most impactful for you and why? Is there anything you want to learn more about?
- 4. Who are some trustworthy people in your life? How do they influence the way you act and live?
- 5. Review the four signs you might have a keeper. Talk about the sign that stood out to you the most. What made it noteworthy or important to you?
- 6. Is there anything you need to change in your friendships or relationships to honor God better? How do you reflect Jesus?
- 7. What are the prayer requests on your mind and heart today?

PRAYER: Father, You know us better than anyone else. We want to honor you in every area of our lives, including our relationships. Please guide us and show us where we can make changes to better reflect who you are. Thank you for redeeming us and calling us your own. In the name of Christ, we pray, Amen.

GOING DEEPER: Read Ruth chapters 1-2. What surprises you the most about Naomi, Ruth, and Boaz up to this point? How is God beginning to re-build their lives after a difficult and tragic time? When have you seen this happen in your own life or the life of someone you know? What can you learn from it to build your faith?

"When Ruth went back to work again, Boaz ordered his young men, 'Let her gather grain right among the sheaves without stopping her. And pull out some heads of barley from the bundles and drop them on purpose for her. Let her pick them up, and don't give her a hard time!' So Ruth gathered barley there all day, and when she beat out the grain that evening, it filled an entire basket... v.19: 'Where did you gather all this grain today?' Naomi asked. 'Where did you work? May the Lord bless the one who helped you!'...

The man I worked with today is named Boaz."
