

# PETER FLAWED YET FAITHFUL

Message: FAITH WHEN LIFE IS MURKY March 1, 2026  
Text: Luke 22:7-16 Pew Bible Page: 876

**BIG IDEA** | TRUST YOUR MASTER, NOT YOUR MASTER PLAN

“Then came the day of Unleavened Bread on which the Passover lamb had to be sacrificed. Jesus sent Peter and John, saying, ‘Go and make preparations for us to eat the Passover.’ ‘Where do you want us to prepare it?’ they asked. He replied, ‘As you enter the city, a man carrying a jar of water will meet you. Follow him to the house that he enters... He will show you a large room upstairs, all furnished. Make preparations there.’ They left and found things just as Jesus had told them. So they prepared the Passover.” Luke 22: 7-13

## MY NOTES:

### GETTING STARTED

Have you ever felt like you were obeying God without fully understanding why? When?

### REFLECTION/DISCUSSION QUESTIONS

1. How do you think Peter and John would have reacted to Jesus’ instructions to find a man carrying a pitcher of water?
2. Besides the desire to be with friends, why might Jesus “eagerly desire” to share this Passover feast with the disciples (v. 15)?
3. Just like physical training, God uses discomfort and unpredictability to grow our faith. Where in your life has God allowed “instability” to stretch your trust in Him?
4. The donkey was tied and ready when the Lord needed it. What does it look like to live with spiritual availability? What part of your life (time, money, margin, gifting) might God be preparing to use in a new way?
5. How does Jesus’ entrance on a donkey reshape your understanding of what greatness looks like?
6. “Trust your Master, not your master plan.” What is something you understand more clearly now than you did in a past season of obedience? How does this impact your faith?
7. What are the prayer requests on your mind and heart today?

**PRAYER:** Lord Jesus, thank you for eating that last Passover meal with your disciples so long ago. You gave instructions for preparations to Peter and John, even though they didn’t fully understand. Help us to follow you, even when we can’t see clearly what you have prepared. In the name of Christ, we pray, Amen.

**GOING DEEPER:** Read Luke 22:7-23 and John 12:12-16. What similarities and differences do you see? How does Jesus explain the significance of the Passover meal in a new light? What does the Lord’s Supper mean for you?
