

BIG IDEA: JESUS GIVES US THE VICTORY AND POWER TO CHANGE

GETTING STARTED

When you were a teenager, what was one of your biggest struggles?

REFLECTION/DISCUSSION QUESTIONS

- 1. From reading this passage, what is your impression of Paul?
- 2. How close did your day come to illustrating the statement: I do not understand what I do?
- 3. What is the root problem of human nature that Paul exposes through his own example (v.14-24)?
- 4. In the midst of his frustrating struggle, what is Paul's hope (v.24-25)?
- 5. In what area of your life is the spirit willing but the flesh weak: Diet? Work habits? Spiritual disciplines? Exercise? Other?
- 6. What can you give thanks to God for despite the struggles you have? How does He give you strength and energy to overcome?
- 7. What are the prayer requests on your mind and heart today?

PRAYER: Lord Jesus, you are good and give us the victory over sin in our lives. So often, the struggle is very real. Thank you for your resurrection power that gives us the ability to change. Help us to seek you in all things. In the name of Christ, we pray, Amen.

GOING DEEPER: Read Romans 7:1-25. According to Paul, what purpose does the law serve? Why do you think God's law was given: (a) Means to follow in order to be saved? (b) Guide to follow once we are saved by grace? (c) Stumbling block, impossible to follow, which points the person to God's grace? How do vs. 10,12, 22 support your answer?
