BIG IDEA: WE EXPERIENCE GRACE BY FAITH THROUGH JUSTIFICATION

GETTING STARTED

When you were growing up, what chores were you expected to do around the house? Did your parents pay you? Why or why not?

REFLECTION/DISCUSSION QUESTIONS

- 1. What is the difference between a wage and a gift? What makes a gift special?
- 2. On the surface, what "qualifications" would seem to make Abraham an example of righteousness? According to Paul, what really made Abraham righteous? (4:9-13)
- 3. When did you first become aware of your own sin and need for God?
- 4. Righteousness by faith through grace—For Martin Luther, John Wesley, and others, this passage changed their lives and world history. How is the message of God's grace impacting your life? (4:21-26)
- 5. How would you sum up the Gospel from chapter 4:23-25? How do you know you are saved?
- 6. Why does it matter to you whether a right relationship with God is a gift to be received or a prize to be earned? How might it matter to your friend?
- 7. What are the prayer requests on your mind and heart today?

<u>PRAYER</u>: Lord Jesus, thank you for your amazing grace. You paved the way so that we could be justified—declared innocent before God. This is an incredible gift, one we do not deserve, but we accept through faith. May we live in your grace all the days of our lives. Amen.

GOING DEEPER: Read Romans 4:1-25. In what way is Abraham a spiritual father to us? What do you learn about faith from the example in vs. 18-22? How would you feel in Abraham's place? In what area of your life can you learn from Abraham and focus not on "working" but on "believing?"
