

GETTING STARTED

Who is someone you admire as a person of prayer?

REFLECTION/DISCUSSION QUESTIONS

- 1. According to this passage, what should you do when you are: in trouble? Happy? Sick? How apt are you to do any of these?
- 2. How is confession and prayer a part of the healing process? What is the connection between the physical and spiritual areas of our life?
- 3. Why pray for the same thing day after day? Why do you persist?
- 4. Share about a time you were disappointed in prayer. What did you do? Did you give up?
- 5. How can you tell if God is answering "Wait" or "No" when you don't see answers to prayer?
- 6. Have you memorized any verses to use in prayer under stress? If so, which ones? What short "breath prayer" feels most authentic for you?
- 7. What are the prayer requests on your mind and heart today?

PRAYER: Lord Jesus, thank you for the ability to communicate with you in prayer. We confess that sometimes prayer feels hard when we don't see the answers that we desire. Help us to persevere and never give up. May we find our strength in you. In the name of Christ, we pray, Amen.

GOING DEEPER: Read James 5:1-20. What does James call Christians to wait for patiently? How does the farmer image relate to our waiting? How does this passage encourage you? Where in your life do you need God's help to patiently persevere?

"Are any of you suffering hardships? You should pray. Are any of you happy? You should sing praises. Are any of you sick? You should call for the elders of the church to come and pray over you, anointing you with oil in the name of the Lord. Such a prayer offered in faith will heal the sick, and the Lord will make you well. And if you have committed any sins, you will be forgiven. Confess your sins to each other and pray for each other so that you may be healed. The earnest prayer of a righteous person has great power and produces wonderful results."
