Message: O HOLY NIGHT

Text: Lamentations 3:20-26
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BIG IDEA | **A NEW DAY WITH CHRIST BRINGS EXACTLY WHAT YOU NEED**

“I will never forget this awful time, as I grieve over my loss. Yet I still dare to hope when I remember this: The faithful love of the Lord never ends! His mercies never cease. Great is His faithfulness; his mercies begin afresh each morning. I say to myself, ‘The Lord is my inheritance; therefore, I will hope in him!’ The Lord is good to those who depend on him, to those who search for him. So it is good to wait quietly for salvation from the Lord.”
Lamentations 3:20-26

GETTING STARTED

What is your favorite Christmas tradition?

REFLECTION/DISCUSSION QUESTIONS

1. O Holy Night—what do you think about the fact that it was originally written and set to music by people who did not know Christ? What does the song mean to you?
2. Why is Jeremiah, the author of Lamentations, so distraught in this section of Scripture? Where does he look for hope? Given the situation, do these words sound hollow? Unreal? Courageous? Other?
3. Share a time when Christ provided you with exactly what you needed.
4. Where in your life do you feel tired and weary? What has caused your weariness?
5. Where in your life are you hoping the morning will come? How can you set your hope in Christ while you wait?
6. How is the hope you have in Christ like no other? How is knowing Christ as your Savior like the dawning of a new day?
7. What are the prayer requests on your mind and heart today?

PRAYER: Lord God, you are the source of our strength and our hope. When we are weary, you never tire. When we are worn out, you remain steadfast. May we bring our needs to you, trusting in hope that you will meet every one of them. It was a holy night when you were born, and we marvel in your most precious gift. In the name of Christ, we pray, Amen.

GOING DEEPER: Read through the book of Lamentations, chapters 1-5. Is this the grief of an individual or of a nation? If repentance is the first step in returning to God’s favor, why is it so difficult? Where in your life is it most challenging to ask for God’s help? What incentive does this book give you to find hope for your future?
