

GETTING STARTED

What stood out to you most from the message or the clip from The CHOSEN? Why?

REFLECTION/DISCUSSION QUESTIONS

- 1. Jesus went out of his way—geographically, culturally, and socially—to meet this woman. What does this tell you about His character?
- 2. The message is called "Not Business as Usual." What does that phrase mean to you in light of the story of the woman at the well?
- 3. From the message: Lie #1—"Religion can solve the problems in my life." In what ways have you looked to rules, rituals, or performance instead of grace? What helps you remember salvation is a gift?
- 4. Lie #2—"My past is so bad, there's no way God can fix me." Have you ever felt disqualified by something in your past? What helped shift your thinking?
- 5. Lie #3—"I need to be an expert before God can use me." How does Jesus' conversation with the woman challenge this idea?
- 6. Where is one area that Jesus is inviting you to "Go and tell" this fall? Serving in a ministry? Participating in a small group/study? Other?
- 7. What are the prayer requests on your mind and heart today?

PRAYER: Lord Jesus, thank you for taking the time to go to Samaria and talk with this woman at the well. It is a reminder that you see each one of us—you know our past—and you want to rescue us and deploy us for ministry. Help us to listen and be obedient to your direction. In the name of Christ, we pray, Amen.

GOING DEEPER: Read John 4:1-30. The woman came to the well for water and left with something eternal. What are you thirsting for in this season? How is Jesus offering something better? What is one way you can slow down this week to sit with Jesus?

"Eventually, Jesus came to the Samaritan village of Sychar, near the field that Jacob gave to his son Joseph. Jacob's well was there; and Jesus, tired from the long walk, sat wearily beside the well about noontime. Soon a Samaritan woman came to draw water, and Jesus said to her, 'Please give me a drink.'... The woman was surprised, for Jews refuse to have anything to do with Samaritans. She said to Jesus, 'You are a Jew, and I am a Samaritan woman. Why are you asking me for a drink?' Jesus replied, 'If you only knew the gift God has for you...I would give you living water."
