PACKING LIGHT

Message: LEAD ME IN PATHS OF RIGHTEOUSNESS June 14, 2026
Text: Psalm 23: 3 Pew Bible Page: 462

BIG IDEA | **A PATH OF RIGHTEOUSNESS IS A RIGHT PATH FOLLOWED WITH THE RIGHT ATTITUDE AND RIGHT PURPOSE.**

"The Lord is my shepherd; I have all that I need. He lets me rest in green meadows; he leads me beside peaceful streams. He renews my strength. He guides me along right paths, bringing honor to his name." Psalm 23:1-3 (NLT). "He guides me along the right paths for his name's sake." (NIV)

"He leads me in the paths of righteousness for His name's sake." (NKJV)

"God does speak—sometimes one way and sometimes another—even though people may not understand it." Job 33:14 (NCV)

MY NOTES:

GETTING STARTED

When walking in a new city, do you: ask for help? consult the map? or find your own way?

REFLECTION/DISCUSSION QUESTIONS

1. What characterizes God's "path?" How would you describe it to someone who is not a Christian?
2. What version of Psalm 23:3 resonates most with you? What stood out to you the most from the message on this verse?
3. What is easiest or hardest for you in seeking God's guidance?
4. Read Job 33:14 below. In what ways has Jesus guided you in the past? How are you depending on his guidance right now?
5. "Sheep tend to wander off the path." Share a time when you perhaps "wandered" and what brought you back to Christ or faith.
6. If you are a VBS volunteer this week, how can your attitude as a "shepherd" affect the "sheep" or students that you lead? How can Jesus' energy sustain you?
7. What are the prayer requests on your mind and heart today?

PRAYER: Lord Jesus, thank you for being our Shepherd, the One who leads us. Help us to be attentive to your direction and follow you. In seasons of comfort, transition, or suffering, may we see your hand and provision. May our lives honor you, for your glory and praise. In the name of Christ, we pray, Amen.

GOING DEEPER: Read Psalm 23:1-3 slowly. How does each phrase relate to the others? When have you wanted to be led by a peaceful stream but you were instead led on a rocky path? What did you learn through that experience? How did God continually guide you?
