

Big Idea

HOW IS THE HOLY SPIRIT FLAME ALIVE IN YOUR LIFE?

GETTING STARTED

Share a time when you traveled and did not speak the native language? What happened?

REFLECTION/DISCUSSION QUESTIONS

- 1. How Why did God wait until Pentecost, a Jewish harvest festival (Deut. 16:9-10) to give the Holy Spirit?
- 2. How far have these pilgrims come (v.9-11)? What attracts them to the disciples? How does being filled with the Holy Spirit relate to bearing witness to Jesus?
- 3. Would you have responded more like those in vs. 12, or those in vs. 13? Why?
- 4. How would you put Peter's answer (v.38-40) in your own words to explain what it means to become a Christian?
- 5. How would you describe your experience with the Holy Spirit now? (On fire, a glowing ember, up in the air, gone with the wind, etc.)
- 6. When are you most aware of the Holy Spirit? (reading God's Word, in a small group, in worship, time alone with God, in nature, etc.) What keeps you filled up?
- 7. What are the prayer requests on your mind and heart today?

PRAYER: God, thank you for pouring out your Holy Spirit upon the first believers in such a powerful way. You are always doing something new! Help us to feel that flame of your Spirit alive in our hearts every day. May you guide and direct us to shine brightly for you. In the name of Christ, we pray, Amen.

GOING DEEPER: Read Acts chapter 2. How are you like Peter in this chapter? Unlike him? What inspires you as you read about Peter? Why? From Peter's message, what facts about Jesus would be key for non-believers to understand (v.29-33)? How would his presentation have affected you on that day?

FOCUS SCRIPTURES: May 28, 2023

"On the day of Pentecost all the believers were meeting together in one place. Suddenly, there was a sound from heaven like the roaring of a mighty wind, and it filled the house where they were sitting. Then, what looked like flames or tongues of fire appeared and settled on each one of them. And everyone present was filled with the Holy Spirit and began speaking in other languages, as the Holy Spirit gave them this ability...

When they heard the loud noise, everyone came running, and they were bewildered to hear their own languages being spoken by the believers."
