

GETTING STARTED

When was the last time you went through a move? What was the best/worst part?

REFLECTION/DISCUSSION QUESTIONS

- 1. Naomi's family moved to Moab. While there she lost her husband and two sons. How might Naomi have been feeling?
- 2. Why did Naomi tell her daughters-in-law to return to their homes? Why did Ruth insist on going with Naomi?
- 3. Which part of this message was most impactful for you and why? At what point in the story can you identify with the events? (dealing with loss, making a choice, etc.)
- 4. Read Judges 21:25. What are some dangers that come with doing what's "right in our own eyes?' How can you practice looking to God for wisdom?
- 5. Share about a time when you were tempted to control your situation (go to Moab) without God? What was the outcome and what did you learn?
- 6. Is there an area of your life that you need to surrender to God? What would it take to make a change?
- 7. What are the prayer requests on your mind and heart today?

PRAYER: Lord God, thank you for your goodness and faithfulness in the story of Ruth. We believe you are good and faithful in our lives, too. Please show us if we need to change the trajectory of some aspect of our lives and help us move in that direction. In the name of Christ, we pray, Amen.

GOING DEEPER: Read Ruth 1:1-22. What has been stressful for you this year? Did you cope like Naomi, Orpah or Ruth? How so? Who is your life is like Ruth, loyal to you in your emptiness? How can you be like Ruth to someone else when needed?

"In the days when the judges ruled in Israel, a severe famine came upon the land. So a man from Bethlehem in Judah left his home and went to live in the country of Moab, taking his wife and two sons with him. The man's name was Elimelech, and his wife was Naomi. Their two sons were Mahlon and Kilion. They were Ephrathites from Bethlehem in the land of Judah. And when they reached Moab, they settled there. Then Elimelech died, and Naomi was left with her two sons. The two sons married Moabite women—one named Orpah, and the other a woman named Ruth. But about ten years later, both Mahlon and Kilion died. This left Naomi alone, without two sons or her husband."
