

BIG IDEA | **NOT MY WILL, BUT YOURS BE DONE**

“Jesus went as usual to the Mount of Olives, and his disciples followed him. On reaching the place, he said to them, ‘Pray that you will not fall into temptation.’ He withdrew about a stone’s throw beyond them, knelt down and prayed, ‘Father, if you are willing, take this cup from me; yet not my will, but yours be done.’ An angel from heaven appeared to him and strengthened him... When he rose from prayer and went back to the disciples, he found them asleep, exhausted from sorrow. ‘Why are you sleeping?’ he asked them. ‘Get up and pray so that you will not fall into temptation.’”
Luke 22:39-46

MY NOTES:

GETTING STARTED

In times of crisis, where do you go? Do you want to be alone or with people?

REFLECTION/DISCUSSION QUESTIONS

1. Where did Jesus go in his time of distress? Did he want to be alone or with people?
2. What are the various emotions Jesus must have felt in Gethsemane? What does he ask of his disciples?
3. What strikes you about Jesus’ prayer? What model for our prayers does Jesus provide here?
4. What has been your “Gethsemane”—a place where you really wrestled with God? What was the issue? What happened?
5. Who would you want to “watch and pray” with you the next time you face a “Gethsemane” moment?
6. How will the Gethsemane story change the way you pray this week? Who do you need to stay up and pray for today?
7. What are the prayer requests on your mind and heart today?

PRAYER: Lord Jesus, thank you for telling the disciples about your prayer that night so long ago. Help us to turn to you in prayer during our times of crisis. May we stay up and pray with those who are going through a hard time. Thank you for the example that you set for all of us. In the name of Christ, we pray, Amen.

GOING DEEPER: Read Luke 22:39-46, Matt. 26:36-46, and Mark 14:32-42. What additional details are found in each account? Why does Jesus single Peter out? “*Could you not keep watch for one hour?*” If Jesus asked you that question, how would you respond? Where might you need to pray: “*Not my will, but yours be done*” in your life right now?
