

GETTING STARTED

When are you most generous: Right after payday? To fill a need? When asked?

REFLECTION/DISCUSSION QUESTIONS

- 1. Why did God want the people of Israel to collect these items? What were they being used to create?
- 2. What impresses you about the materials needed and collected: Extravagant? Useful? Colorfully symbolic? Nothing but the best for God? Gifts of love? Out of place in the wilderness?
- 3. What is the connection between gratitude and generosity? How does giving demonstrate something of God's nature?
- 4. Why is "willingness" or "eagerness" emphasized so much in this passage? What stands out here?
- 5. How important is a willing heart to God when it comes to giving? (see 2Cor 9:7) Do you give eagerly or out of a sense of obligation?
- 6. Where is God calling you to invest in Redeemer in the upcoming year with your time, your talents, and your resources?
- 7. What are the prayer requests on your mind and heart today?

<u>PRAYER</u>: Father, thank you for your unconditional grace. Thank you for all that you have given to us. Please help us to live generously out of your grace, so we can care for others. We want to give with joy, out of the overflow of gratitude in our lives. In Jesus' name, we pray, Amen.

<u>GOING DEEPER</u>: Read Exodus 35:1-36:7. Notice what happens at the end of this passage. Why did the giving exceed all expectations? How would the church react if the people gave too much this year? What dreams could be fulfilled? How can you be a part of giving generously for God's work?

"So the whole community of Israel left Moses and returned to their tents. All whose hearts were stirred and whose spirits were moved came and brought their sacred offerings to the Lord. They brought all the materials needed for the Tabernacle, for the performance of its rituals, and for the sacred garments. Both men and women came, all whose hearts were willing... vs. 29: "So the people of Israel - every man and woman who was eager to help in the work the Lord had given them through Moses - brought their gifts and gave them freely to the Lord."
