Big Idea: STRETCH YOUR COMMITMENT AND EXPAND YOUR INFLUENCE

GETTING STARTED

If your house were on fire, what three things would you save and why?

REFLECTION/DISCUSSION QUESTIONS

- 1. What does the prophet Isaiah mean by using this image of enlarging your tent? How did it encourage the Israelites in exile?
- 2. When Jerusalem was rebuilt after the exile, it did not regain the influence and status it had before. How was the prophet helping to paint a picture of what could be if they enlarged their capacity?
- 3. Think about a time in your life when you were asked to stretch your commitment (sports, band, graduate program, etc.)? What motivation helped you reach higher?
- 4. What "stream in the desert" is bubbling up for you now? Where is God opening up a place to expand your influence?
- 5. What "new thing" (v.19) has the Lord done in your life? What is he doing now? Where is he asking you to stretch your commitment?
- 6. Why do you give to Redeemer Church? What ministries do you love to support as you give to God through Redeemer?
- 7. What are the prayer requests on your mind and heart today?

PRAYER: Amazing God, thank you for this challenge to step out in faith to enlarge our capacity and expand our influence. May we be obedient to stretch our commitment and follow where you ask us to go. Give us joy and peace as we rest in your peace and promises. In the name of Christ, we pray, Amen.
