BIG IDEA: CALLING IS ABOUT WHO YOU ARE BEFORE WHAT YOU DO

GETTING STARTED

When you were a kid, what did you want to do when you grew up? How close is it to now?

REFLECTION/DISCUSSION QUESTIONS

- 1. As Jesus came up out of the water as he was being baptized, what did the voice from heaven say? What would you like to hear God say to you?
- 2. Why did the disciples decide to follow Jesus (v.18)? How might Zebedee have felt (v.20)?
- 3. Do you normally give much thought to your calling? Why or why not?
- 4. What would change about your life if you believed that your calling isn't just about what you do but about who you're becoming?
- 5. When have you struggled to know God's calling on your life? When have you felt sure of it?
- 6. What are some small and large ways God might be calling you to be faithful today?
- 7. What are the prayer requests on your mind and heart today?

PRAYER: Lord, Jesus, thank you for your call to those first disciples so long ago. Thank you for their willingness to set down their nets and follow you. Help us, also, to be willing to follow you when you call us, in big and small ways. May we have hearts ready to be "fishers of people" in every area of our lives. In the name of Christ, Amen.

GOING DEEPER: Read Mark 1:9-20 and Matthew 3:13-17 and 4:18-22. What are the similarities and differences in the two gospels? In the baptism section, how has God affirmed you as his child in Christ? In the call section, where do you find yourself? Spiritually, are you preparing the nets? Leaving the boat in some area? Following hard after Jesus? Feeling left behind? What is Jesus calling you to be and to do?
