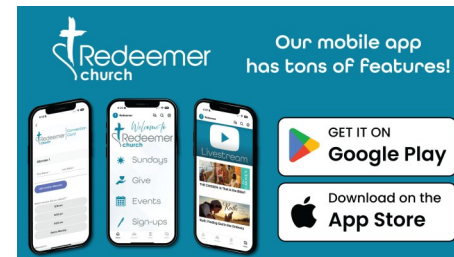

"The serpent was the shrewdest of all the wild animals the Lord God had made. One day he asked the woman, 'Did God really say you must not eat the fruit from any of the trees in the garden?' 'Of course we may eat fruit from the trees in the garden,' the woman replied. 'It's only the fruit from the tree in the middle of the garden that we are not allowed to eat. God said, 'You must not eat it or even touch it; if you do, you will die.' 'You won't die!' the serpent replied to the woman. 'God knows that your eyes will be opened as soon as you eat it, and you will be like God.'"

GETTING STARTED

What food do you find especially tempting?

REFLECTION/DISCUSSION QUESTIONS

1. Which portion of the serpent's statements (v.1,4,5) are true and which are false (compare 3:4-5; 3:22; 5:5)? Why do you think the serpent mixes the truth with lies?
2. Compare Eve's responses (v.2,3) with what God actually said and did (2:9,16,17). How does Eve change God's commandments?
3. What strategies does the serpent use to tempt Eve, and how do you see similar patterns in your own life today?
4. In what situations are you most likely to doubt God's goodness or misrepresent His word?
5. Genesis 3 shows how sin damages our relationships with God and with others. How does this help us to understand the world that we see today?
6. How does this passage show God's grace to Adam and Eve despite their sin? How have you seen God working in your own life in the midst of failure or brokenness?
7. What are the prayer requests on your mind and heart today?

PRAYER: Lord God, help us to see your truth, even in the midst of temptation. We know that sin taints everything. In our broken world, thank you for your grace. May we seek to know you through it all. In the name of Jesus, we pray, Amen.

GOING DEEPER: Read Genesis 3:1-24. Compare vs. 7-13 with the previous chapter. How has the relationship changed between the man and the woman? With God? Why do they engage in the original 'cover-up?' (2:25, 3:7) How easy is it for you to admit you are wrong?
