



GETTING STARTED

Who was your first "boss"? Was this person easy to work for or a slave driver?

REFLECTION/DISCUSSION QUESTIONS

- 1. 'There is no condemnation for those who belong to Christ Jesus.' What do you do with the flashbacks and voices in the night that keep reminding you of your past mistakes?
- 2. From vs.1-4, how would you explain the Gospel to someone who feels they are not "good enough" for God?
- 3. Where is the battle for the control of your life going to be fought...and won or lost? (see Romans 8:5-7)
- 4. What does it mean to be "led by the Spirit?" (v.14) How does the Spirit help us fight our battles? Give an example.
- 5. What is the best part of being in the family of God?
- 6. What does it mean to you that you are not God's slave, but his child?
- 7. What are the prayer requests on your mind and heart today?

PRAYER: Lord God, thank you that we can call you "Abba, Father." You invite us to this close relationship of being your son or daughter. We do not live in fear of your approval. We do not have to live in shame. We can live in the security of a family relationship. We are truly grateful. Help us to be led by your Spirit daily. In the name of Christ, Amen.

GOING DEEPER: Read Romans 8:1-27. When unhealthy thoughts enter your mind, what have you found helpful in dealing with them? In vs.5-11, what does Paul say about the option Christians have in living their life? What reason for hope do you find in this passage? What is the difference between the hope of a Christian and wishful thinking?

"So now there is no condemnation for those who belong to Christ Jesus. And because you belong to him, the power of the life-giving Spirit has freed you from the power of sin that leads to death."

"So you have not received a spirit that makes you fearful slaves. Instead, you received God's Spirit when he adopted you as his own children. Now we call him, 'Abba, Father.' For his Spirit joins with our spirit to affirm that we are God's children. And since we are his children, we are his heirs. In fact, together with Christ we are heirs of God's glory."
