

Big Idea:

KEEP LOOKING FORWARD WITH EYES ON JESUS

GETTING STARTED

In our society, how is success generally measured? Where do you feel pressured to meet this standard?

REFLECTION/DISCUSSION QUESTIONS

- 1. What does Jesus tell his disciples not to do? Why? What does Jesus urge them to do instead? Why? What will result?
- 2. Why does Jesus use birds of the air and lilies of the field as examples? Do they resonate with you? Why or why not?
- 3. What causes you the most worry? What is God saying to you through this passage about handling your particular worry or disappointment?
- 4. How do you seek to be proactive in your generosity? How do you give to God your first-fruits, not your leftovers?
- 5. V.27: 'Who of you by worrying can add a single hour to his life?' What is Jesus saying in this verse? What does it mean to you?
- 6. What is one thing you can do in the coming week to "seek FIRST his kingdom and his righteousness?
- 7. What are the prayer requests on your mind and heart today?

<u>PRAYER</u>: Lord Jesus, thank you for your examples in in this passage, teaching us not to worry. Help us to keep our eyes focused on you. May we seek you first in all that we do, including the way that we give and live out our calling to generosity. In the name of Christ, we pray, Amen.

<u>GOING DEEPER</u>: Read Matthew 6:19-34. How does the way we handle our treasures relate to the concept of worry? Why does Jesus talk about them together? What is easy or difficult for you about giving to God through the church? How have you trusted God to be your Provider?
