Genesis 35:1-6; 1 Cor. 9:24-27

Big Idea:

CHOOSE DISCIPLINE NOW OVER REGRET LATER

GETTING STARTED

Have you ever signed up for a gym? How many times? How long did it last? What did you learn?

REFLECTION/DISCUSSION QUESTIONS

- 1. What memories or feelings would Jacob associate with Bethel (see Gen. 28:10-22)? Why do you think God now asks him to return there?
- 2. What impresses you about Jacob in this story? How does his family respond to his leadership?
- 3. "Discipline is choosing between what you want now and what you want most." How does this statement play out in your own life?
- 4. Share a story of when you were able to choose discipline over regret. What worked for you?
- 5. What do you want most? What do you need to do differently now to achieve the thing you want most?
- 6. What goals could you set this summer that would require you to rely on God's strength and grace?
- 7. What are the prayer requests on your mind and heart today?

<u>PRAYER</u>: Holy Spirit, we need your power. We need your help to choose discipline now so we don't have regret later. We know what to do, and then we do what we know we shouldn't. Give us the ideas, power, and grace to stick with discipline. In the name of Christ, Amen.

GOING DEEPER: Read Genesis 28:10-22 and 35:1-15. What is your "Bethel"—where God has met you in times of stress? What makes this place so meaningful? If you were to bury something under the oak at Shechem, what would you bury? Jacob built an altar in response to God's blessing. How has God blessed you lately?

FOCUS SCRIPTURES:

"Then God said to Jacob, 'Go up to Bethel and settle there, and build an altar there to God, who appeared to you when you were fleeing from your brother Esau. So Jacob said to his household and to all who were with him, 'Get rid of the foreign gods you have with you, and purify yourselves and change your clothes. Then come, let us go up to Bethel, where I will build an altar to God, who answered me in the day of my distress and who has been with me wherever I have gone.' So they gave Jacob all the foreign gods they had and Jacob buried them under the oak."
