DIG DEEP

READ: Matthew 5:27-30 (NIV)

27 "You have heard that it was said, 'You shall not commit adultery.' 28 But I tell you that anyone who looks at a woman lustfully has already committed adultery with her in his heart. 29 If your right eye causes you to stumble, gouge it out and throw it away. It is better for you to lose one part of your body than for your whole body to be thrown into hell. 30 And if your right hand causes you to stumble, cut it off and throw it away. It is better for you to lose one part of your body than for your whole body to go into hell.

- ∞ What have you typically heard that Jesus meant by these verses?
 - » Why did Jesus only list the right eye and hand? Does that mean it's acceptable to commit adultery if you're left-eye dominant and left handed?
 - » How literal do you think Jesus was speaking regarding gouging eyes and chopping off hands?
 - » The meaning of "causes you to stumble" (σκανδαλίζει - skandalizei) -
 - » Who is Jesus talking to, and who is he *not* talking to? What difference does that make?

READ: Matthew 5:31-32 (NIV)

31 "It has been said, 'Anyone who divorces his wife must give her a certificate of divorce.' 32 But I tell you that anyone who divorces his wife, except for sexual immorality, makes her the victim of adultery, and anyone who marries a divorced woman commits adultery.
