READ Luke 2:8 & 9

8 And there were shepherds living out in the fields nearby, keeping watch over their flocks at night. **9** An angel of the Lord appeared to them, and the glory of the Lord shone around them, and they were terrified.

READ Luke 2:10-14

10 But the angel said to them, "Do not be afraid. I bring you good news that will cause great joy for all the people. **11** Today in the town of David a Savior has been born to you; he is the Messiah, the Lord. **12** This will be a sign to you: You will find a baby wrapped in cloths and lying in a manger."

13 Suddenly a great company of the heavenly host appeared with the angel, praising God and saying, **14** "Glory to God in the highest heaven, and on earth peace to those on whom his favor rests."

° Why do you think the shepherds were "terrified?" What first thoughts would come to your mind if a host of angels appeared before you?

∞ What does God's choice of the shepherds say about His character?

∞ Why do you think God chose the outcast shepherds over the priests?

∞ Why didn't God announce Christ's birth to the wealthy and influential (see Luke 18:23-25)?

READ Luke 2:15-20

15 When the angels had left them and gone into heaven, the shepherds said to one another, "Let's go to Bethlehem and see this thing that has happened, which the Lord has told us about."

16 So they hurried off and found Mary and Joseph, and the baby, who was lying in the manger. **17** When they had seen him, they spread the word concerning what had been told them about this child,

18 and all who heard it were amazed at what the shepherds said to them. **19** But Mary treasured up all these things and pondered them in her heart. **20** The shepherds returned, glorifying and praising God for all the things they had heard and seen, which were just as they had been told.

∞ What does it say about God's character that He would ask the shepherds to **come as they are**, instead of giving them some ceremonial cleansing rituals to go through first?
