



## Psalm 111

[1] Praise the LORD! I will give thanks to the LORD with my whole heart, in the company of the upright, in the congregation.

[2] Great are the works of the LORD, studied by all who delight in them.

[3] Full of splendor and majesty is his work, and his righteousness endures forever.

[4] He has caused his wondrous works to be remembered; the LORD is gracious and merciful.

[5] He provides food for those who fear him; he remembers his covenant forever.

[6] He has shown his people the power of his works, in giving them the inheritance of the nations.

[7] The works of his hands are faithful and just; all his precepts are trustworthy;

[8] they are established forever and ever, to be performed with faithfulness and uprightness.

[9] He sent redemption to his people; he has commanded his covenant forever. Holy and awesome is his name!

[10] The fear of the LORD is the beginning of wisdom; all those who practice it have a good understanding. His praise endures forever! (ESV)

## Romans 2:29

[29] But a Jew is one inwardly, and circumcision is a matter of the heart, by the Spirit, not by the letter. His praise is not from man but from God. (ESV)

## John 4:34

[34] Jesus said to them, "My food is to do the will of him who sent me and to accomplish his work. (ESV)

## John 5:17

[17] But Jesus answered them, "My Father is working until now, and I am working." (ESV)

## John 6:27–29

[27] Do not work for the food that perishes, but for the food that endures to eternal life, which the Son of Man will give to you. For on him God the Father has set his seal." [28] Then they said to him, "What must we do, to be doing the works of God?" [29] Jesus answered them, "This is the work of God, that you believe in him whom he has sent."

## Ephesians 2:8–10

[8] For by grace you have been saved through faith. And this is not your own doing; it is the gift of God, [9] not a result of works, so that no one may boast. [10] For we are his workmanship, created in Christ Jesus for good works, which God prepared beforehand, that we should walk in them. (ESV)

## *His Work – Our Food – His Praise!*

Psalm 111 – March 1, 2026

For the following application questions, review your notes from the front.

### **SUNDAY after church...**

Think through the morning and: 1) List and praise the Lord for specific encouragement you were able to give. 2) List and praise the Lord for specific encouragement you received. 3) List songs that touched your heart.

**MONDAY – READ & PRAY:** Prayerfully and expectantly read a portion of God’s Word. Write down something to chew on. **WATCH:** How has the Lord shown you Himself and His work? **DISCUSS:** What work has the Lord given you to do? What happens when we can’t work?

**TUESDAY – READ & PRAY:** Prayerfully and expectantly read a portion of God’s Word. Write down something to chew on. **WATCH:** How has the Lord shown you Himself and His work? **DISCUSS:** What is the work of Christ? What does His work tell us about His heart? Is it easy or difficult for you to answer the question: “how did you see the Lord work yesterday/last week?” Why?

**WEDNESDAY – READ & PRAY:** Prayerfully and expectantly read a portion of God’s Word. Write down something to chew on. **WATCH:** How has the Lord shown you Himself and His work? **DISCUSS:** Do you long to study the redemptive work of Jesus? How does all His work flow from this? How is His work our food? Share an experience of this.

**THURSDAY – READ & PRAY:** Prayerfully and expectantly read a portion of God’s Word. Write down something to chew on. **WATCH:** How has the Lord shown you Himself and His work? **DISCUSS:** Where does the help come from when we struggle to see God’s work? Where does our help come from when we struggle to praise Him? Share a time when you have been helped to remember His work.

**FRIDAY – READ & PRAY:** Prayerfully and expectantly read a portion of God’s Word. Write down something to chew on. **WATCH:** How has the Lord shown you Himself and His work? **DISCUSS:** How have the hands of the saints helped feed your soul with the work of Christ? How does it feed our soul to know His work and praise endures forever?

**SATURDAY – READ & PRAY:** Prayerfully and expectantly read a portion of God’s Word. Write down something to chew on. **WATCH:** How has the Lord shown you Himself and His work? **PREP & PRAY:** Prayerfully ready your heart for the Sunday gathering. Pray for every element of Body Life that He is drawing us into tomorrow. How is God calling you to help build His church?
