# O Praise the Name!

Psalm 113:1-3 - October 5, 2025

For the following application questions, review your notes from the front.

### SUNDAY after church...

Think through the morning and: 1) List and praise the Lord for specific encouragement you were able to give. 2) List and praise the Lord for specific encouragement you received. 3) List songs that touched your heart.

**MONDAY** —**READ & PRAY:** Find a good Bible reading plan, a good time, and a good place to commune with God. **WATCH:** How has the Lord shown you Himself and His work? **DISCUSS:** If you had a "name tracker" attached to your lips, what name would make the most tallies? Why? Would Jesus be near the top?

**TUESDAY** — **READ & PRAY:** Find a good Bible reading plan, a good time, and a good place to commune with God. **WATCH:** How has the Lord shown you Himself and His work? **DISCUSS:** Remember a time over the past few weeks where you have delighted in praising the Lord.

**WEDNESDAY** — **READ & PRAY:** Find a good Bible reading plan, a good time, and a good place to commune with God. **WATCH:** How has the Lord shown you Himself and His work? **DISCUSS:** Can you force praise of the Lord? What should we do when we don't feel it as an overflow of our hearts? What should we do when we don't sense it from our children (natural and God's family)?

**THURSDAY** – **READ & PRAY:** Find a good Bible reading plan, a good time, and a good place to commune with God. **WATCH:** How has the Lord shown you Himself and His work? **DISCUSS:** Does the setting and rising of the Son still take your breath away? Is He superior to the most splendid sunset or sunrise?

**FRIDAY** — **READ & PRAY**: Find a good Bible reading plan, a good time, and a good place to commune with God. **WATCH**: How has the Lord shown you Himself and His work? **DISCUSS**: Is it possible to praise the Lord *at all times* of your life? Where are some *places* the Lord is calling you to bring praise to His name?

**SATURDAY** — **READ & PRAY**: Find a good Bible reading plan, a good time, and a good place to commune with God. **WATCH**: How has the Lord shown you Himself and His work? **DISCUSS & BUILD**: How are you going to build up the Body of Christ tomorrow as we gather to worship Jesus?
