## *Jesus Reigns: Built by the Waves*

Psalm 93 – March 8, 2026

For the following application questions, review your notes from the front.

### **SUNDAY after church...**

Think through the morning and: 1) List and praise the Lord for specific encouragement you were able to give. 2) List and praise the Lord for specific encouragement you received. 3) List songs that touched your heart.

**MONDAY – READ & PRAY:** Prayerfully and expectantly read a portion of God’s Word. Write down something to chew on. **WATCH:** How has the Lord shown you Himself and His work? **DISCUSS:** Is there anything visible or invisible, spiritual or physical that you believe is outside the reign of the Lord? Does your life and mood match this belief? How does the “length of His robe” affect our perception of His majesty?

**TUESDAY – READ & PRAY:** Prayerfully and expectantly read a portion of God’s Word. Write down something to chew on. **WATCH:** How has the Lord shown you Himself and His work? **DISCUSS:** Why does man struggle with the sovereignty of God over all things? How does faith in His sovereignty over all things build up His Church? How do we see Christ’s sovereignty at the cross?

**WEDNESDAY – READ & PRAY:** Prayerfully and expectantly read a portion of God’s Word. Write down something to chew on. **WATCH:** How has the Lord shown you Himself and His work? **DISCUSS:** Do the nations raging against the Lord and His people trouble you? How does Psalm 93 help? How can the church in Iran and the church in America agree in prayer?

**THURSDAY – READ & PRAY:** Prayerfully and expectantly read a portion of God’s Word. Write down something to chew on. **WATCH:** How has the Lord shown you Himself and His work? **DISCUSS:** How does Jesus build with waves and floods? Have you experienced this? Testify.

**FRIDAY – READ & PRAY:** Prayerfully and expectantly read a portion of God’s Word. Write down something to chew on. **WATCH:** How has the Lord shown you Himself and His work? **DISCUSS:** What is an area of your life or in the life of our world that you need to proclaim Psalm 93 over? How does it clarify His majesty? Pray to see His goodness in the flood. How can we encourage a brother or sister who is in a season of flood? Do it!

**SATURDAY – READ & PRAY:** Prayerfully and expectantly read a portion of God’s Word. Write down something to chew on. **WATCH:** How has the Lord shown you Himself and His work? **PREP & PRAY:** Prayerfully ready your heart for the Sunday gathering. Pray for every element of Body Life that He is drawing us into tomorrow. How is God calling you to help build His church?
