John 14:1-9 (ESV)

¹“Let not your hearts be troubled. Believe in God; believe also in me.

²In my Father’s house are many rooms. If it were not so, would I have told you that I go to prepare a place for you?

³And if I go and prepare a place for you, I will come again and will take you to myself, that where I am you may be also. ⁴And you know the way to where I am going.”

⁵Thomas said to him, “Lord, we do not know where you are going. How can we know the way?”

⁶Jesus said to him,

“I am the way, and the truth, and the life.

No one comes to the Father except through me.

⁷If you had known me, you would have known my Father also.

From now on you do know him and have seen him.”

⁸Philip said to him, “Lord, show us the Father, and it is enough for us.”

⁹Jesus said to him, “Have I been with you so long, and you still do not know me, Philip?

Whoever has seen me has seen the Father. How can you say, ‘Show us the Father’?”

SUNDAY after church...

Think through your morning and: 1) List and praise the Lord for specific encouragement you were able to give!
2) List and praise the Lord for specific encouragement you received! 3) List songs or lyrics that touched your heart.

MONDAY

READ: See the John 14:1-9. **DISCUSSION STARTED:** Also read Ecclesiastes 2:23 and Job 5:6-7; 14:1. Write out what kinds of troubles we face. Why is our world full of troubles/ (Use verses if you can. Why are we so surprised and discouraged when we see troubles?

PRAY: Pray over your applications.

TUESDAY

READ: John 14:1-9. **DISCUSSION STARTER:** Write out why these disciples' hearts were troubled. Think of this exact evening and what was to come. Write out if you have had disappointments similar. How does the commonality of troubles help you to be prepared?

PRAY: Pray over your applications.

WEDNESDAY

READ: See John 14:1-9. **DISCUSSION STARTER:** Write out why Jesus' future for us is "better". List all you can think of (see verses on front) How does this help you with troubles today? **PRAY:** Pray over your applications.

THURSDAY

READ: John 14:1-9. **DISCUSSION STARTER:** We often think of check lists, or simply lists. If we need to go somewhere or get somewhere, we make a list (turn west, stay straight, go 10 miles. Turn south). When we think of overcoming something, we usually think this way. Now read John 14:6 again and write out how it is different when Jesus says, "I am..." rather than do this and do that.

PRAY: Pray over your applications!

FRIDAY

READ: See 14:1-9. **DISCUSSION STARTER:** Read again Jude 24-25 (on front). How does this verse help you as you look at either your troubles, of a loved-ones. How does this verse help? **PRAY:** Pray over your application!

SATURDAY

Prepare your heart for Sunday's gathering by being ready to fully engage in the worship.
