

VBS Sunday! June 23, 2024 – John 14:1, 25-31

John 14:1, 25–31 ¹"Let not your hearts be troubled. Believe in God; believe also in me.

²⁵"These things I have spoken to you while I am still with you. ²⁶But the Helper, the Holy Spirit, whom the Father will send in my name, he will teach you all things and bring to your remembrance all that I have said to you.

²⁷Peace I leave with you; my peace I give to you. Not as the world gives do I give to you.

Let not your hearts be troubled, neither let them be afraid.

²⁸You heard me say to you, 'I am going away, and I will come to you.'

If you loved me, you would have rejoiced,

because I am going to the Father, for the Father is greater than I. ²⁹And now I have told you before it takes place, so that when it does take place you may believe.

³⁰I will no longer talk much with you, for the ruler of this world is coming. He has no claim on me,

³¹but I do as the Father has commanded me, so that the world may know that I love the Father. Rise, let us go from here.

When your heart is troubled, Jesus provides!

1. When your heart is troubled, Jesus gives calmness! The Holy Spirit explains and reminds you of His Word! (25-26) John 16:13; 1 Corinthians 2:10; John 2:22

2. When your heart is troubled, Jesus gives peace! (27) Isaiah 9:6; John 20:19,21,26; Philippians 4:7; Romans 5:1

3. When your heart is troubled, Jesus gives joy and trust! He tells you of His exaltation with the Father! (14:28-29) Revelation 4-5! Isaiah 6

4. When your heart is troubled, Jesus gives security! He tells you He has overcome the ruler of the world! (30-31) John 12:31; 16:33

5. When your heart is troubled, Jesus gives security! He shows you He loves the Father! (14:27) John 17:21,23

--- Revelation Demands Response ----

When your heart is troubled – learn to first ask for help!

SUNDAY after church...

MONDAY

READ today's verses. **DISCUSSION STARTED**: We have done this before...but list things this week that trouble your heart. Can you write out why these things trouble your heart? **PRAY**: Pray over your applications.

TUESDAY

READ today's verses. **DISCUSSION STARTER:** Read verses 25-26 and write out how these ministries of the Helper (Holy Spirit) actually help you with a troubled heart. Be as specific as you can. **PRAY:** Pray over your applications.

WEDNESDAY

READ today's verses. **DISCUSSION STARTER:** Read verse 27. Write out how Jesus has given you peace during a troubling time. Be as specific as you can. **PRAY:** Pray over your applications.

THURSDAY

READ: today's verses. **DISCUSSION STARTER:** Read verses 28-29 and write out how understanding and "seeing" Jesus exalted, helps you with trust and joy. Be as specific as you can. **PRAY:** Pray over your applications!

FRIDAY

READ: today's verses.. **DISCUSSION STARTER:** Read verse 30 and write out how knowing of Jesus' victory over the evil one helps your troubled heart. Be as specific as you can. **PRAY:** Pray over your application!

SATURDAY Prepare your heart for Sunday's gathering by being ready to fully engage in the worship.
