



Psalm 150

[1] Praise the LORD! Praise God in his sanctuary; praise him in his mighty heavens!

[2] Praise him for his mighty deeds; praise him according to his excellent greatness!

[3] Praise him with trumpet sound; praise him with lute and harp!

[4] Praise him with tambourine and dance; praise him with strings and pipe!

[5] Praise him with sounding cymbals; praise him with loud clashing cymbals!

[6] Let everything that has breath praise the LORD! Praise the LORD! (ESV)

Isaiah 29:13

[13] And the Lord said: "Because this people draw near with their mouth and honor me with their lips, while their hearts are far from me, and their fear of me is a commandment taught by men,"

Romans 8:9–11

You, however, are not in the flesh but in the Spirit, if in fact the Spirit of God dwells in you. Anyone who does not have the Spirit of Christ does not belong to him. [10] But if Christ is in you, although the body is dead because of sin, the Spirit is life because of righteousness. [11] If the Spirit of him who raised Jesus from the dead dwells in you, he who raised Christ Jesus from the dead will also give life to your mortal bodies through his Spirit who dwells in you. (ESV)

Ephesians 1:16–19

[16] I do not cease to give thanks for you, remembering you in my prayers, [17] that the God of our Lord Jesus Christ, the Father of glory, may give you the Spirit of wisdom and of revelation in the knowledge of him, [18] having the eyes of your hearts enlightened, that you may know what is the hope to which he has called you, what are the riches of his glorious inheritance in the saints, [19] and what is the immeasurable greatness of his power toward us who believe, according to the working of his great might (ESV)

Ephesians 3:14–18

[14] For this reason I bow my knees before the Father, [15] from whom every family in heaven and on earth is named, [16] that according to the riches of his glory he may grant you to be strengthened with power through his Spirit in your inner being, [17] so that Christ may dwell in your hearts through faith—that you, being rooted and grounded in love, [18] may have strength to comprehend with all the saints what is the breadth and length and height and depth, (ESV)

- 6. Praise the LORD: higher and forever.**

Psalm 150 – March 22, 2026

For the following application questions, review your notes from the front.

SUNDAY after church...

Think through the morning and: 1) List and praise the Lord for specific encouragement you were able to give. 2) List and praise the Lord for specific encouragement you received. 3) List songs that touched your heart.

MONDAY – READ & PRAY: Find a good Bible reading plan, a good time, and a good place to commune with God. **WATCH:** How has the Lord shown you Himself and His work? **DISCUSS:** Does the praise of Psalm 150 match the vibrancy in your own heart towards the Lord? (It's ok to say yes, and it's good to share struggles we need help with.)

TUESDAY – READ & PRAY: Find a good Bible reading plan, a good time, and a good place to commune with God. **WATCH:** How has the Lord shown you Himself and His work? **DISCUSS:** What inhibits red-hot, Psalm 150 praise in your heart? What helps to stir it? How can people or problems be mighty in your heart? How can problems be turned to praise?

WEDNESDAY – READ & PRAY: Find a good Bible reading plan, a good time, and a good place to commune with God. **WATCH:** How has the Lord shown you Himself and His work? **DISCUSS:** How does God reveal Himself to us? How have you seen His goodness? Is praise possible without tasting?

THURSDAY – READ & PRAY: Find a good Bible reading plan, a good time, and a good place to commune with God. **WATCH:** How has the Lord shown you Himself and His work? **DISCUSS:** Is the cross the first thing that comes to mind when thinking of God's mighty works? Does His mighty work continue in your heart – even in the hum-drum of life?

FRIDAY – READ & PRAY: Find a good Bible reading plan, a good time, and a good place to commune with God. **WATCH:** How has the Lord shown you Himself and His work? **DISCUSS:** Gather with a group of saints and share what redeemed, musical instrument the Lord has forged you into for His praise. 😊

SATURDAY – READ & PRAY: Find a good Bible reading plan, a good time, and a good place to commune with God. **WATCH:** How has the Lord shown you Himself and His work? **DISCUSS & BUILD:** How are you going to build up the Body of Christ tomorrow as we gather to worship Jesus?
