How do you build a strong, enduring church amidst a hostile culture?

Love one another!

John 13:34-35. Also see: Romans 13:8–10; Galatians 5:14; 6:2; James 2:8; Matthew 22:37-40; 1 Cor. 13:4-7

→ Four ways to "love one another":

1) Always pursue purity!

Having **purified** your souls by your obedience to the truth (22a) from a **pure** heart, (22b); James 2:1-4; Proverbs 4:23
Pure – unpolluted from selfishness and self-exaltation!

* a ditch: Don't be a hypocrite or double minded! a **sincere** brotherly love (v.22c)

2) Always be a friend!

brotherly love (v.22c)

Love one another with *brotherly affection*. (Rom. 12:10) > affectionate. Kind. Friendly. A companion *John 15:12-15*

3) Always be diligent and eager!

love one another earnestly ((v.22) > to reach out or stretch! Hebrews 10:24-25; Luke 22:44; Acts 12:5

MONDAY

READ Sunday's verses. **DISCUSSION STARTED** Read John 13:34-35 again. Write out your observations on how this new command affects the stability of a local church.

PRAY: Pray over your observations and applications.

TUESDAY

READ Sunday's verses. **DISCUSSION STARTER**: *Pure* or *to purify* means to be unpolluted. Many things can pollute our love for one another. List some that you need to watch out for. Read Proverbs 4:23 after you write your list. **PRAY**: Pray over your observations and applications.

WEDNEDAY

READ Sunday's verses. **DISCUSSION STARTER:** Someone said, when looking for a new church, "We're looking for friends, not friendly". Write out what you think they mean by this. What is the difference between the two? **Pray:** Pray over your applications. **Pray:** Pray over your applications.

THURSDAY and FRIDAY

READ Sunday's verses. **DISCUSSION STARTER:** To love earnestly, means to be reaching, stretching out towards others. This would for sure be the opposite of neglecting to meet together. From our study of 1 Peter 1:222-25, write out how you can remind yourself of being eager and diligent to reach out to others in love. **Pray:** Pray over your applications.
