For we know that the law is spiritual; but I am of the flesh, sold into slavery under sin. I do not understand my own actions. For I do not do what I want, but I do the very thing I hate. Mark 6:14-29 Introductory verse 6b: As Jesus went round to villages teaching, he summoned the Twelve and sent them out two by two with authority over the unclean spirits.....

Now, King Herod heard of Jesus' for his name had become known. Some were saying, 'John the baptizer has been raised from the dead; it is for this reason these powers are at work in him.' But others said, 'It is Elijah.' And others said, 'It is a prophet, like one of the prophets of old.' But when Herod heard of it, he said, 'John, whom I beheaded, has been raised.'

For Herod himself had sent men who arrested John, bound him, and put him in prison on account of Herodias, his brother Philip's wife, because Herod had married her. For John had been telling Herod, 'It is not lawful for you to have your brother's wife.' Therefore, Herodias had a grudge against

him and wanted to kill him. But she could not, for Herod ***feared John, knowing that he was a righteous and holy man, and he protected him. When he heard him, he was greatly perplexed; and yet he liked to listen to him.*** But on Herod's birthday an opportunity came. He gave a banquet for his courtiers, officers, and the leaders of Galilee. When his daughter Herodias came in and danced, she pleased Herod and his guests; and Herod said to the girl, 'Ask me for whatever you wish, and I will give it.' And he solemnly swore to her, 'Whatever you ask me, I will give you, ***even half of my kingdom.***' She went to her mother and said, 'What should I ask for?' She replied, '***The head of John the baptizer.***' Immediately she rushed back to the king and requested, 'I want you to give me, here and now, the head of John the Baptist on a platter.' ***The king was greatly distressed*** yet because of his oath and his guests, he could not bring himself to refuse her. Immediately the king sent a soldier of the guard with orders to bring John's head. He went to the prison and beheaded John. Then he brought the head on a platter and gave it to the girl. The girl in turn gave it to her mother. When John's disciples heard about it, they came and took his body, and laid it in a tomb.
