Something Helpful – Different Types of God's Laws Moral Law - "mitsva" – ordinance, order or commandments

(laws based on God's holiness that do not change)

Ceremonial Law - "hukkim" - custom of the nation

(laws based on approaching God before the death of Christ, and laws based on issues particular to the Jews in OT times)

Judicial Law – "mishpat" – decisions or judgment

(ramifications for breaking laws particular to the Jews in OT times)
