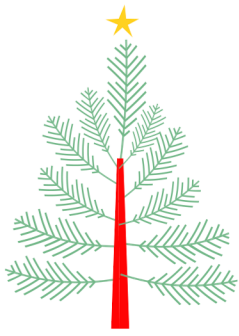

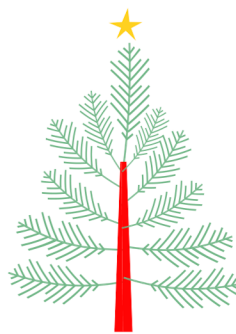

# Week 1 Day 1

Isn't it amazing that God knows everything? He knows the things that have happened in the past, the things happening now and even what will happen in the future.

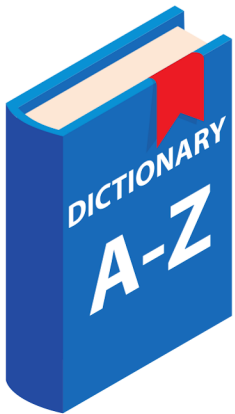
And guess what? God can do all things. He can tell exactly what will happen in the future and can also make it happen exactly how he said it would.

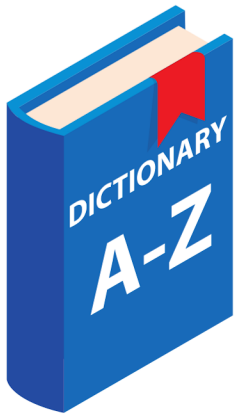

Remember that Jesus, the savior of the world was born in Bethlehem, a town that was the least important among the ruling cities of Judah.

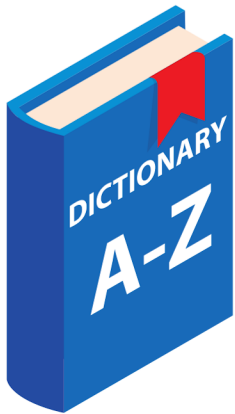
God can make greatness and success come out from the least and unimportant people and places. He wants your name and story to be heard just like the city of Bethlehem. Always know that God has great plans for your life.

Remember that God's angels are always present to protect and shield you from all evil. (Psalm 91:11)

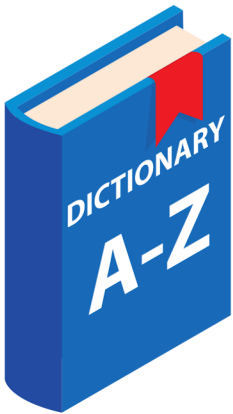

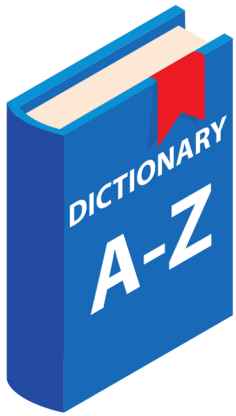
God has many promises in his word. God promised to send a savior to the world a long time ago, and he did not fail to keep his promise. God always keeps his promises no matter how long it takes.

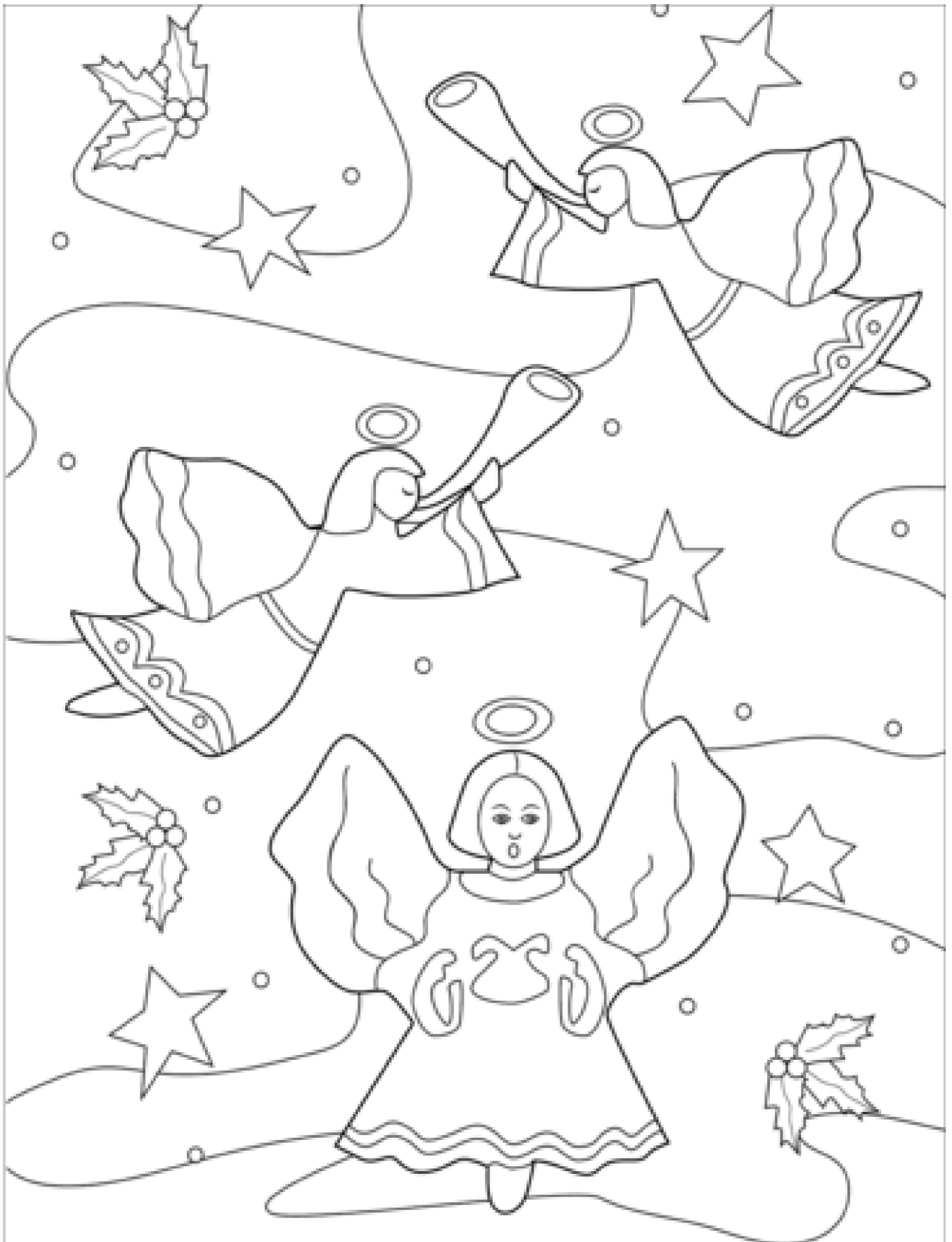

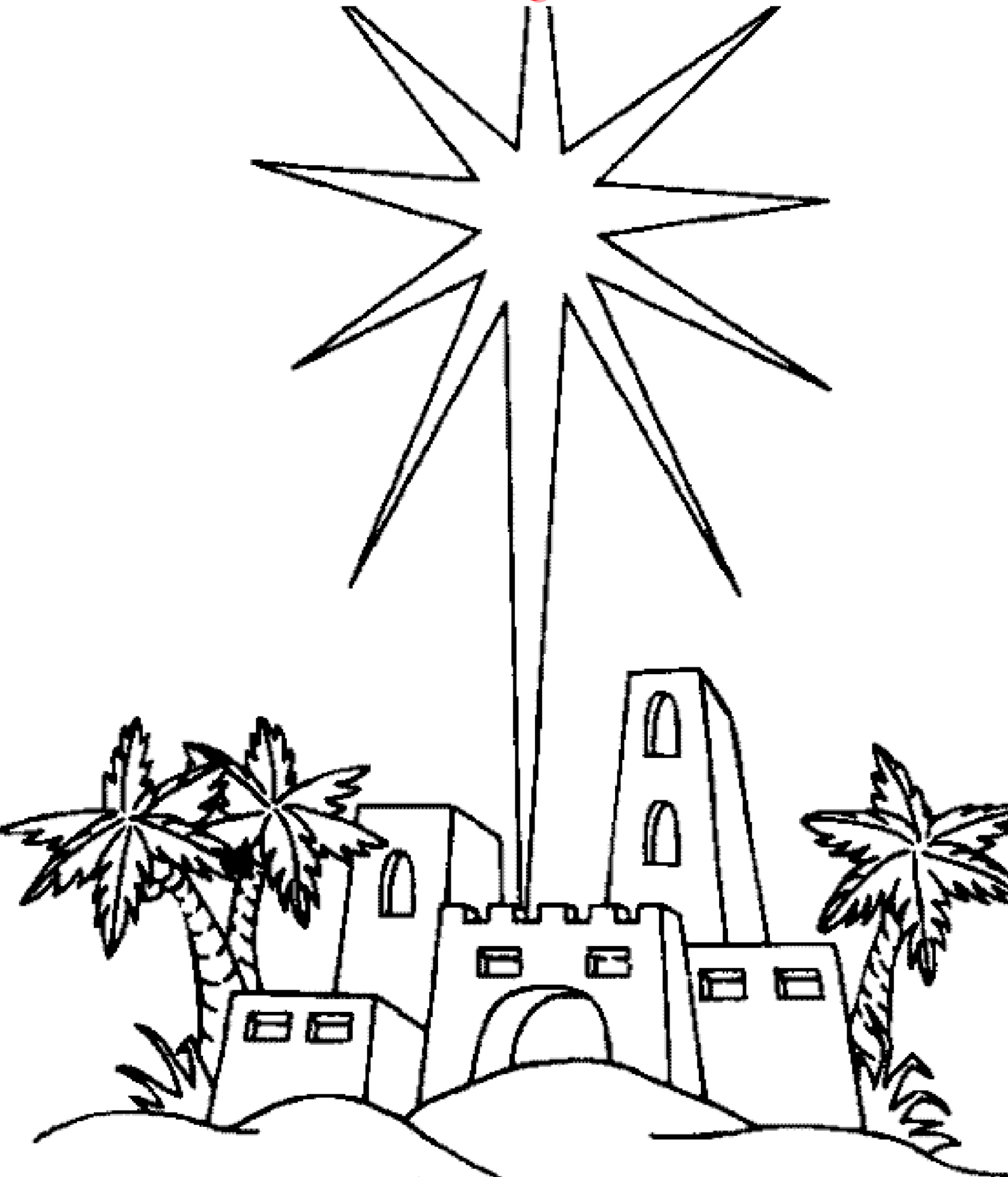

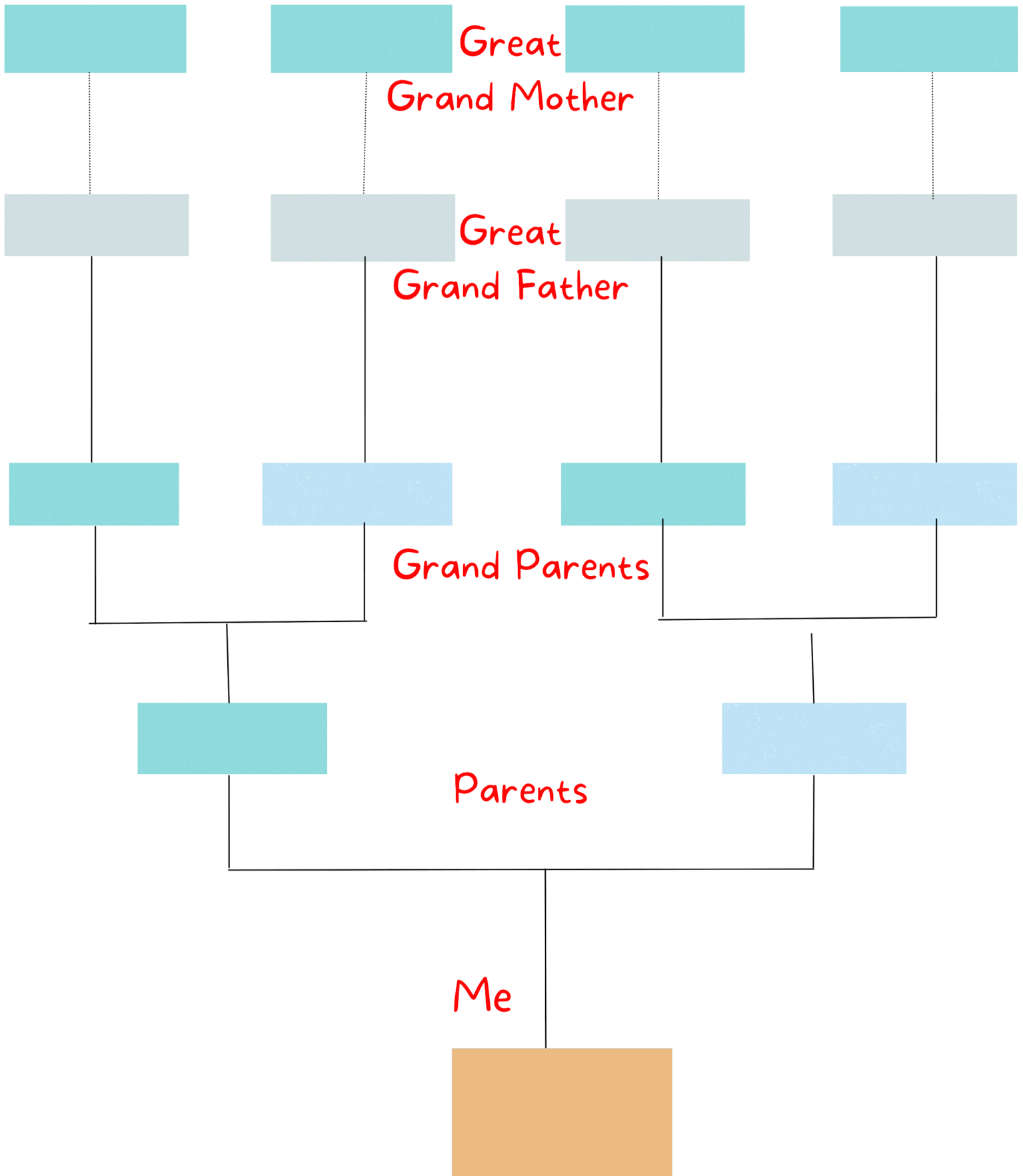

# Family Tree

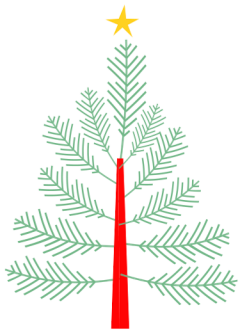

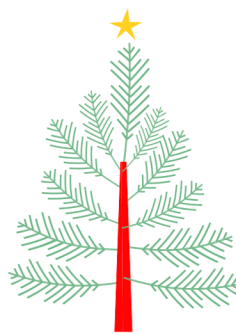

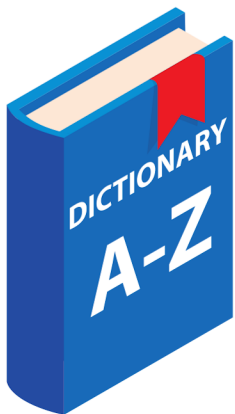
Do you always obey God and do good things? Do you believe God when he says something to you? God wants us to always obey and believe him.

God can do impossible things, and that is exactly what he promised to do for Zechariah and Elizabeth. He fulfilled his promise by blessing them with a special child, John the Baptist.

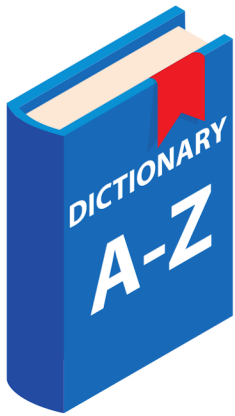

Do you give in church? One way we can show respect and love to Jesus Christ is by giving him gifts. You can also show the people you love that you value and admire them by giving them precious gifts.

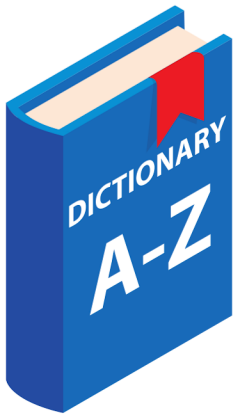

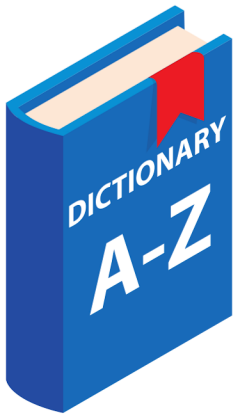

God warned the Wise men in a dream not to return to Herod. He also sent an angel to tell Joseph to take the child Jesus to Egypt as Herod was looking to kill Jesus. Joseph stayed in Egypt with his family till King Herod died.

Have you ever wanted something that someone else had? Were you mean to that person or say mean things about them? How did you feel when you made someone sad just because you were jealous? Jealousy is like sticky slime on your heart and God does not want His children to be filled with jealousy. King Herod was jealous of the child Jesus and so he killed children from 2 years and younger. Jealousy in King Herod's heart turned him into a murderer. So today, ask God to forgive you for being jealous, and thank God for what you have.

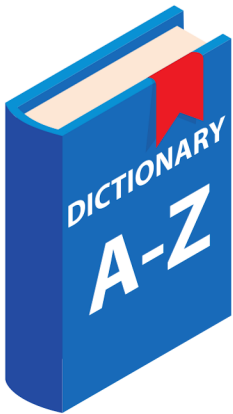

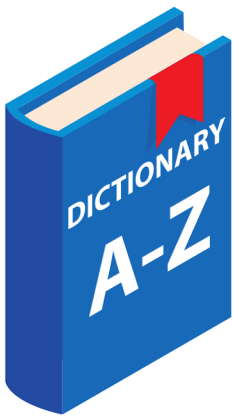
Choosing to be simple will help you not to be anxious and remain focused on what is important

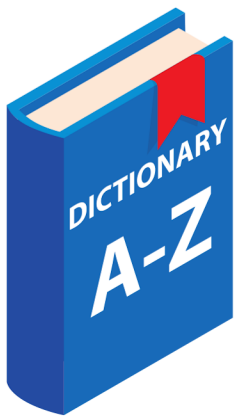
No matter how long it takes or how difficult life has been, when you see the Promises of God do what Anna did, give thanks. Share JESUS with others who need THE REDEEMER.

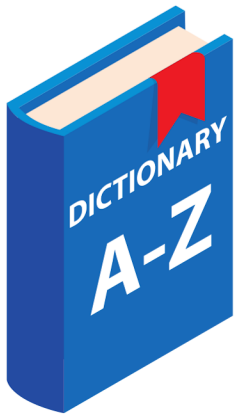

## JESUS OUR SAVIOUR

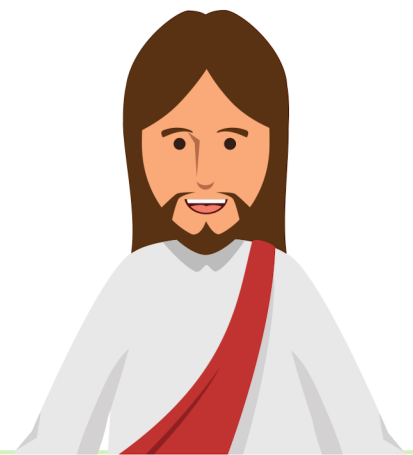


Luke 2 : 10-11

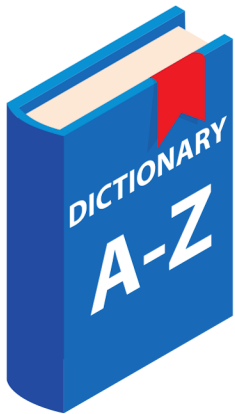

Jesus is always with us. He saved us from sin and His kingdom is forever. Always remember that He does not want you to be separated from him. You are never alone

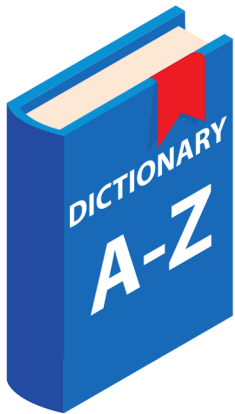

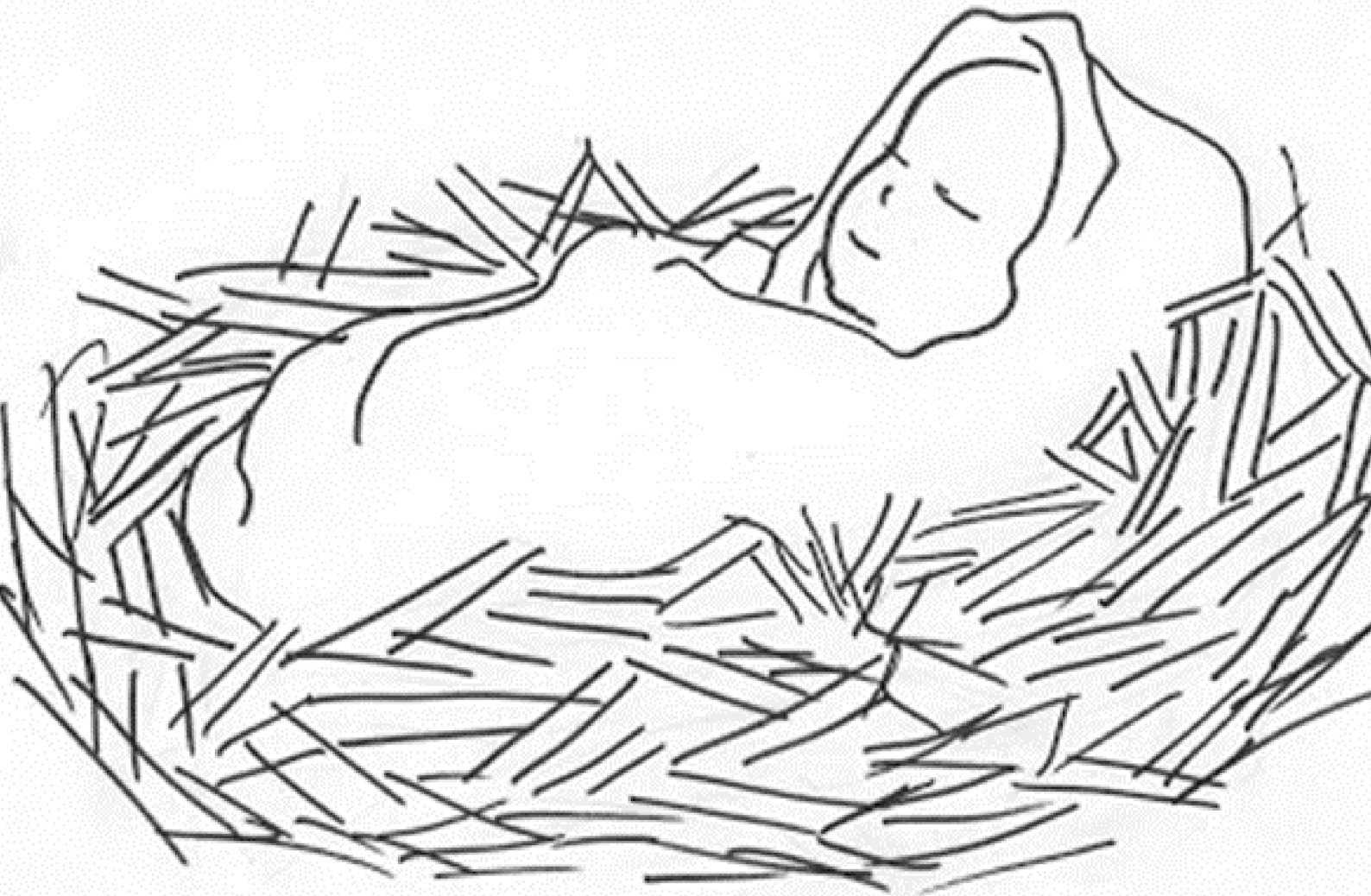
