- When have you experienced a "wilderness season" in your life? What made it feel like a wilderness, and how did it affect your relationship with God?
- David began Psalm 63 by seeking God even when life was painful and confusing. When life gets difficult, what are you most tempted to seek for comfort, answers, or relief instead of God?
- The sermon suggests that God often does some of His deepest work in difficult seasons. Looking back, can you identify a hardship that God used to shape your character, faith, or dependence on Him?
- David chose to remember God's faithfulness in the past while facing uncertainty in the present. What are some specific ways God has shown His faithfulness in your life that can encourage you in current struggles?
- The message ends with the idea: "Give me Jesus. You can have all this world." What would it practically look like for you to pursue Jesus as your greatest need and hope this week, regardless of your circumstances?
