THE MOUNTAIN IS CALLING

- The message starts by saying talent or success doesn't automatically make someone worth following. What qualities make someone trustworthy enough to model your life after?
- The Beatitudes describe the kind of life God calls "blessed." Which of those qualities (humility, mercy, peacemaking, hunger for justice, etc.) do you find most challenging to live out, and why?
- Jesus says His followers are "salt" and "light." What might it look like in your everyday relationships to bring "God's flavor" or "God's light" into the lives of people around you?
- Jesus warns about doing good things for recognition and about chasing security through possessions. Where do you see the pull toward recognition, status, or security affecting your priorities?
- Jesus ends the sermon by comparing two lives: one built on rock and one built on sand. What would it practically look like for someone to build their life on Jesus' teachings instead of just hearing them?

Key Verse: Matthew 7:24, 24 "Anyone who listens to my teaching and follows it is wise, like a person who builds a house on solid rock.
