### **THE MOUNTAIN IS CALLING**

- The message talks about getting a “peek behind the curtain.” What do you think Jesus was trying to reveal to His disciples through these encounters with Gentiles?
- In the story of the Gentile woman, the disciples wanted to send her away. What does their reaction reveal about their beliefs, and how does Jesus challenge that mindset?
- Jesus heals many Gentiles and then feeds the 4,000. What do these actions tell us about who Jesus came for and what God cares about?
- The number seven appears in the feeding miracle and often represents completeness in Scripture. What might this detail suggest about God’s provision and His plan for all people?
- If Jesus came for everyone, how should that shape the way we view and interact with people in our everyday lives? Who might God be calling you to reach or care for right now?

Key Verse: Matthew 15:37 They all ate as much as they wanted. Afterward, the disciples picked up seven large baskets of leftover food. 38 There were 4,000 men who were fed that day, in addition to all the women and children.
